- Cluster will send a summary of the AWD issues relevant for ESNFI cluster
- 3. Updates:
- a) Flood response / DFID kits
- In support of transportation and distribution of the DFID kits donated to NDRMC; SCI has commenced distribution and has started the distribution of 4177 kits to Shabelle/Korahe zones
- Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) is preparing to transport and distribute 8,284 ES NFI kits to the Sitti, Faafan and Ngob areas of Somali region. NRC has requested additional funding from the EHE
- NDRMC is positioning 17,500 ES NFI kits in the regional warehouses in SNNP. Afar and Oromia regions. These kits are waiting for further distribution. 1500 Hygiene kits and 1800 water filters are waiting for distribution in Adama warehouse
- b) Gambella response update
- During week 24, the ICRC (with ERCS Gambella branch) distributed (blankets, mats, jerrycans x 2) (kitchen sets & tarpaulins x 1) for 1315 households (app 7,890 persons)
- c) Somali Oromia Border
- IRC is planning to provide 2.000 kits to the Kumbi Conflict.
- IOM plans to distribute ESNFI and dignity kits to 1,178hhs in Babile Woreda in Somali region
- An Intercluster rapid assessement is planned in second week July in Hudat and filtu woredas of liban zone (border conflict on Somali and Oromia border)
- d) AWD outbreak Addis Ababa
- WHO pubishes a weekly situation report. In the issue of 18-24th June the national nr of AWD cases is 3323 and 31 death. In Addis 1,092 cases and one death.
- FMOH and partners are managing the AWD cases in 14 designated treatment centres, another 11 are planned.
- ESNFI cluster is asked for buckets and jerry cans
- e) Scabies response IOM/UNICEF/WHO
- No change in situation: IOM, UNICEF & WHO have received funding to respond to scabies affected population. Most of the funds for NFI's are still with IOM and goods not yet procured because the need is not confirmed and the planning of the WHO and UNICEF response not clear.

Distribution of NFI's to scabies victims only makes sense in combination with health or hygiene response.

- f) Belg Assessment:
- Assessment is finalized and the reports are coming in. In many of the regions observations and recommendation are made for ES NFI interventions
- g) Meher contingency planning
- Cluster provides the ESNFI input in the national Meher / Kirempts Contingency planning. All IDP's will be targeted with ESNFI kits.
- h) La nina 2016 2017
- OCHA is working on a presentation with the La Nina impact scenario for 2016 2017. The sea water temperature indicators of La Nina in 2016 look very similar to 2010 2011 situation. In those years heavy rains were followed by a period of severe drought from October onwards leading to unprecedented need for water trucking. AP: ESNFI cluster will share La Nina presentation

4. ES/NFI kit specification (TWIG)

ESNFI cluster proposes to review on the composition / standards of the NFI kits. It can be
considered to make adaptations per hazard and region. A TWIG was conducted on the 28th of
June (previous to the cluster meeting) but the participation was low. Need for regional
specification and user guidance for dignity kits was identified. AP: Call new TWIG on ES/NFI kits.

5. Combined Procurement & distribution pipeline: SOP

- The ESNFI cluster wants to analyses if combined procurement is interesting for (some) cluster members. ESNFI cluster has collected price information from 10 suppliers for the 15 item ES NFI kit. AP: share detailed ESNFI kit price overview.
- Next steps is that IOM will collect samples of each supplier. After this a meeting will be conducted with the interested cluster partners.
- A separate presentation will be held for the donors.
