

A special meeting on East and West Hararge Response was held on 21st July 2016. For Emergency Shelter & NFIs, IMC/IRC and ICRC/ERCS have the capacity to respond and will coordinate with each other. Additional stocks are available with NDRMC and IOM.

3. Information Management:

The cluster shares ES & NFI status projection for 2016.

The estimate IDPs forecast is based on the Meher contingency plan, report displacement Jan-Jun 2016, flood displacement figures from November-December of 2014 and 2015, as well as average displacement based on conflict.



Cause of displacement in the first six months of 2016 has been 57% flood, 10% drought and 33% conflict.

It was noted that the projected displacement figures of over 272,000 is significantly higher than the 150,000 stated in HRD. However, it is also expected that with long lead time for procurement, many of the temporary displacement caseloads will have already return to place of origin.

4. Updates:

NDRMC requests that reports on distribution of DfID's emergency shelter and NFIs kits by NRC and SCI also be shared with NDRMC. The cluster coordinator has agreed to follow up, as the agencies have previously shared that distributions are on-going.

ACF and GOAL enquire to the possibilities of requesting for NFIs to supplement their ongoing implementations. At present, there is no established procedures for placing requests with cluster members, but it will be important for the agencies to share areas they are currently working in and have capacity to distribute NFIs.

Guidelines and SOPs for responding and reporting to requests coming from Regions and Zones should be established.

It is important to establish clearer criteria for beneficiary selection purposes.
