Technical Update

- Draft strategy, outlining potential emergency shelter support options (tents, tarpaulins, NFI, etc.)
- How we can support recovery process through differentiated recovery options (BBS training, IEC material, potential cash/voucher programs)
- Assistance Modalities, advantages and disadvantages of materials in kind, cash, voucher, catalogue. Materials in kind and catalogue might be strongest options, but market analysis would be key in this approach
- From key informant interviews in a few communities came some suggestions of note: need for power, generators, chainsaws, tools outside of tool kits, and cross cutting issues including psycho/social impact and protection issues
- BBS material have continued to be revised and updated. Will be circulated for partner consensus, ministry approval and available then for wider distribution
- George We have ntoiced WASH issues, what is WASH/Shelter collaboration?
 - o Intersectoral reach out to WASH cluster
 - wash building codes
 - o Resources on website
 - o Could have joint shelter/WASH cluster meeting

Evacuation Centers

- EC working group now active, and important to have all clusters present
- ETM is wrapping up, results to be shared
- General trends are seeming to be in line with assumptions
 - o evac centers down, needs not
 - o shelter highest need
 - shelter kit may not address shelter needs
 - o preliminary round vs further round
 - o if you have any important questions or requests, submit to cluster team to



send to George and Syann. List in order of priority

- Sense from ETM from places of origin?
 - Yes, feed into shelter planning so displaced people can know when distirbutions will happen in their places of origin
- ECWG of cluster leads discussing generally cross cutting issues, preliminary assessments done but more throrough analysis to be done, undestanding needs of people still in ECs.
 - o Potential for partners to contribute enumerators for further assessments.

Assessments

- Sharing of assessments, call for more
- Standardizing forms so that they can be left and used by Min of Housing
- Assessment registry, uploading assessments
- Care to release some too
- Check assessment database to see what assessments have been done, to avoid duplication
