



2016 Humanitarian Response Plan + New caseload from Anbar/Falluiah crisis (in June 2016)




27 Cluster partners submitted 40 proposals, prioritizing the delivery of assistance to conflict affected persons in 12 of the 18 governorates of Iraq where shelter/NFI needs have been identified as most acute.

To date, 68% of cluster target has been reached with full basic NFI kits distributions (includes 61% in Centre and South (C&S) and 7% In KR-I) and 18% of cluster target has been reached with Shelter interventions (includes 15% in Centre and South (C&S) and 2% in KR-I).
