- Al Alam 3 camp has received 492 families so far according to the camp Manager currently hosted in sectors 1, 2 and 3.
- 200 families from Hawija originally hosted in informal settlements in Al Alam
- 292 families directly from Hawija
- 137 families have not received CRIs since they arrived two weeks ago, UNHCR database shows these families have received CRIs before, UNHCR and Camp Management working to resolve this problem.
- CRIs Gaps also reported in Shahama Camp for new arrivals.

### 4. Cluster response updates on:

- 3 Ws matrix, Needs and Gap Analysis shared with Partners to fill and indicate areas they intend to respond.

## 5. Tent Replacement: Needs; Achievements; Gaps

- 150 tents required for replacement in sector 1 in Al Alam Camp
- Most of the tents in MODM camps in Al Alam 3 have collapsed; ropes keeping the tents up have been vandalized. DRC / Camp Management in Al Alam intends to provide ropes and re install some of the tents.
- Camp Management reported most of the tents in MODM sector 4 have been vandalized
