

DISPLACEMENT


Since the start of 2017, the cluster has received reuest for assistance to almost 51,000 households who have been displaced racross 3 regions of Gambela (2,116 households), Oromia (24,460 households), and Somali (23,766 households).







DISTRIBUTION


By the 16th of February, the cluster had reached some 5,257 households with emergency shelter material or household nonfood items such as kitchen set and beddings. Of those assisted, 16% were displaced by conflict and 84% by drought.











STOCK & PIPELINE

The cluster has 21,706 emergency shelter and household NFI kits in country, with an additional 12,600 kits being procured. Based on existing capacity and the expected increase In need to respond to on-going displacements, coupled with known supplies currently under procurement, the cluster is expected to reach 46% of those targeted in the 2017 HRD.
