

Half DAY WORKSHOP

"Technical Assistance, Monitoring and Evaluation Support to the Settlement Recovery Programme" - West Sumatra.

Introduction:

As the Post Recovery of Padang Earthquake is almost reaching a year by September 2010, the present scenario of overall Recovery does not seem to be achieving the desired results. Government chose the path of Recovery by Cash stimulus program to empower the communities to construct their own permanent Houses by providing 15 million for a severely damaged and 10 million for a moderately damaged House in two installments. In the first pilot phase 7634 Households (4% of the entire damaged Houses) are to be covered under Cash Stimulus Program during April to July 2010. Government has also unveiled their Second phase of Cash Stimulus Program to Cover 140000 House Holds from August to December 2010. Apart from Government Cash Stimulus program, limited numbers of NGO's are trying to start their own permanent House Reconstruction in small pockets.

Around 300 facilitators have been recruited and trained, who are managed by KMK, the district level construction management consultants. These recruited facilitators are now implementing pilot phase 1, to oversee the reconstruction of 7634 house, which gives responsibility to each of the facilitator's team of two, to oversee two Pokmas with around 50 houses

Government has announced recently to start their Phase 2A Cash stimulus program as part of providing support to 140000 Households. In regards to government's implementation plan of housing cash stimulus program for the phase II, government has reducing the scope of coordination and management responsibility by appointing Penanggung Jawab Operasi Kegiatan - PJOK (Project Manager) in every district and will no longer utilize KPA from department of public works at provincial level which used to be responsible for management of the whole pilot project. Accordingly, the cash stimulus fund will also be transferred directly from PPK RR of BNPB account at national level to the account of PJOKs at district level before it is then transferred to POKMAS accounts. In addition, the second phase will utilize different structure compared to the pilot project mechanism (phase one). In the second phase, KMK (district management consultants) will have their facilitator coordinators posted in every subdistrict (kecamatan) instead of at district level as it used to be.

Technical support to TPT/PU: At the Provincial level UN-Habitat is closely coordinating with TPT and PU the main implementing agencies for the padang Earthquake Recovery in Housing Sector. UN-Habitat continuously organized many coordination meetings to strengthen the Reconstruction policy by providing Technical assistance regarding i) Finding Gaps and present them to TPT in the present first phase of Government Cash Stimulus Program ii) Facilitators Training for 30% of first phase facilitators on Community based earthquake recovery and Technical training on Earthquake resistant House Construction iii) Outreach Programs to disseminate good construction methods through films, posters and Focus Group discussions.

To share the lessons learned and the experiences during UN Habitat Training of Facilitators and Outreach program as part of technical support to the Government Housing Recovery program.
