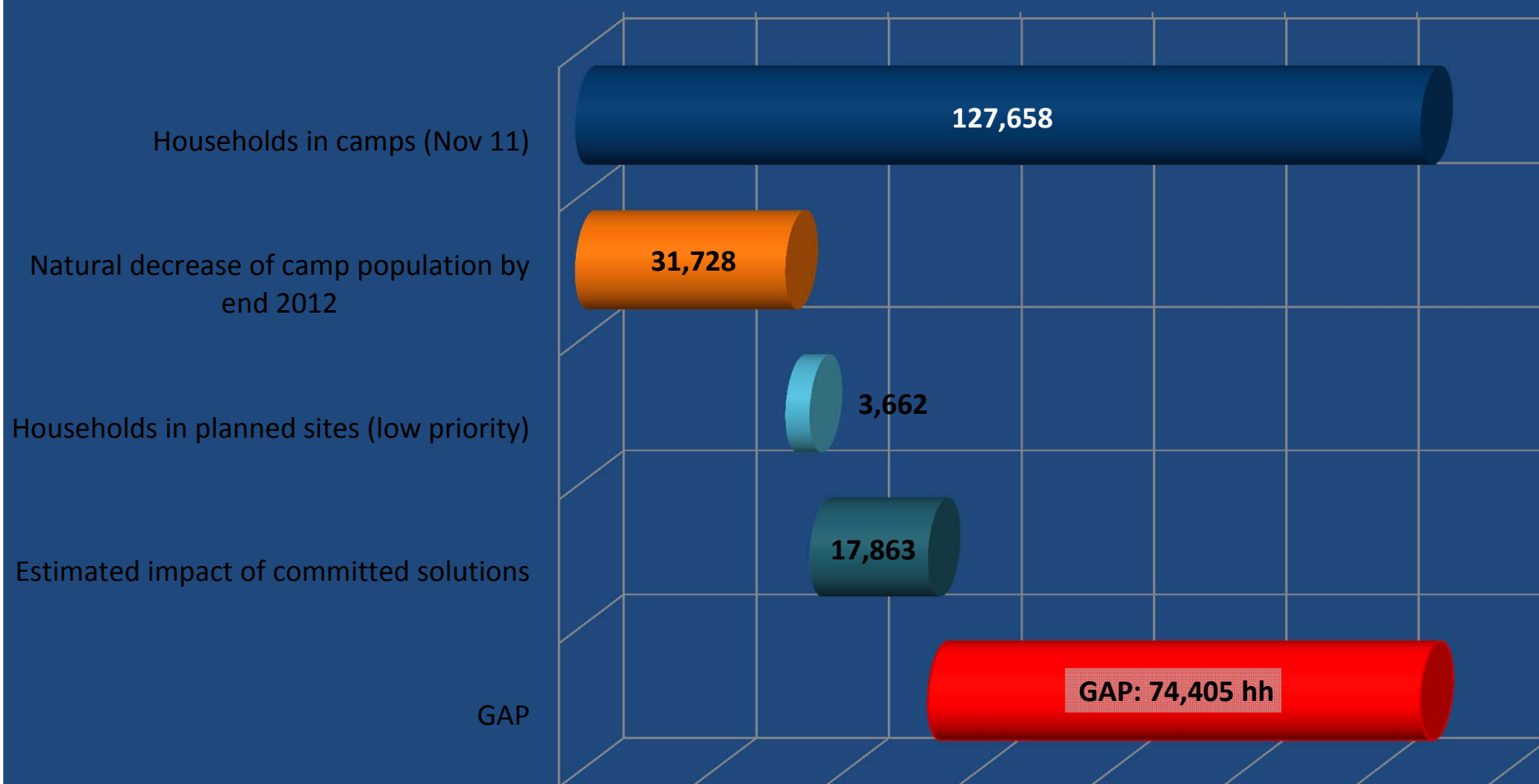

Projection of camp-based population for 2012



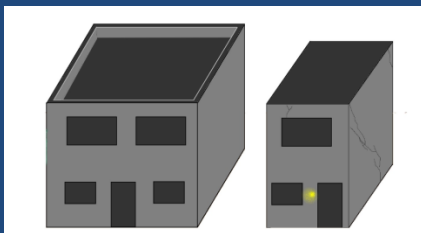

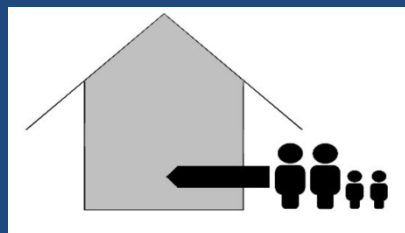
Recommendations

74,405 additional return solutions required

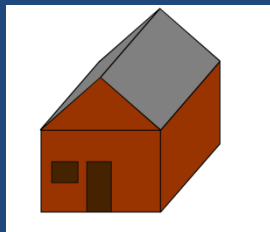
Targeting people in camps



= 24,000 additional permanent housing solutions



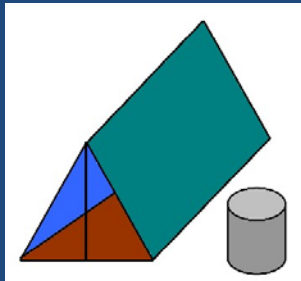
= 30,000 additional Rental subsidy solutions



= 20,000 additional Transitional shelters

Cluster activities in 2012

If large populations remain in camps due to a lack of return solutions, the following actions will be urgently required:



Organize contingency stocks to prepare camps for hurricane season 2012

Organize emergency shelter replacement and repair in camps

Advocacy:

1. Under 400 return solutions would close camps in Petit & Grand Goave

2. Under 2,300 return solutions would close camps in Léogane & Gressier

3. 50% of beneficiaries of Return solution programs should be camp-based population

4. More yellow house repair and permanent house reconstruction should be targeting people in camps
