

Displacement updates in North-West Syria

Some **2.74 million IDPs** are living in North-West Syria, out of them **1.9 million** are living in IDP sites registered in ISIMM. That brings the total population in North-West Syria close to **4.6 million**.

According to CCCM Cluster, as of April **4,536 displacement movements** (-11,215 compared to the previous month) were recorded. While, there were **8,403 IDP returnee** movements (+4,739 compared to the previous month) were tracked.

The top three sub-district of arrival were Dana, Idleb, and Qurqeena sub-district. The top sub-district of IDP departure were Dana, Daret Azza and Janairis sub-district.

Response

Shelter/NFI Cluster members continue to actively respond to the needs of the newly displaced persons, as well as protracted IDPs in North-West Syria.

In April 2023, more than 21,000 individuals received NFI assistance, in the form of NFI kits, winter clothes kits and kitchen sets.

Shelter needs of over 37,000 individuals were responded to in April, including infrastructure improvements in IDP sites, the transitional shelters, provision of emergency shelter, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

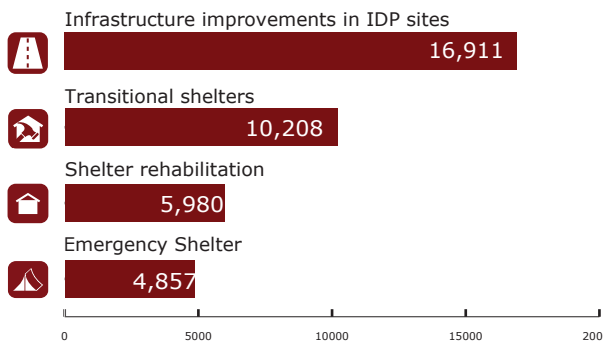

People reached in April by shelter activity



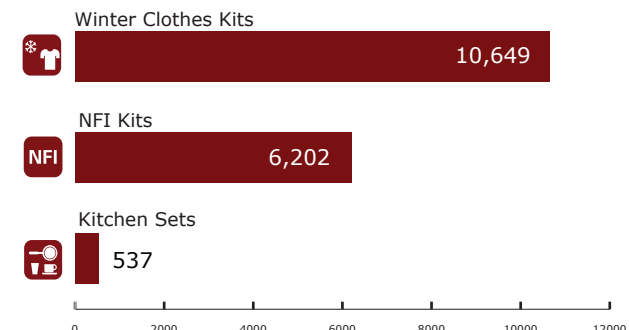
NFI response

People reached in April by NFI in-Kind items assistance



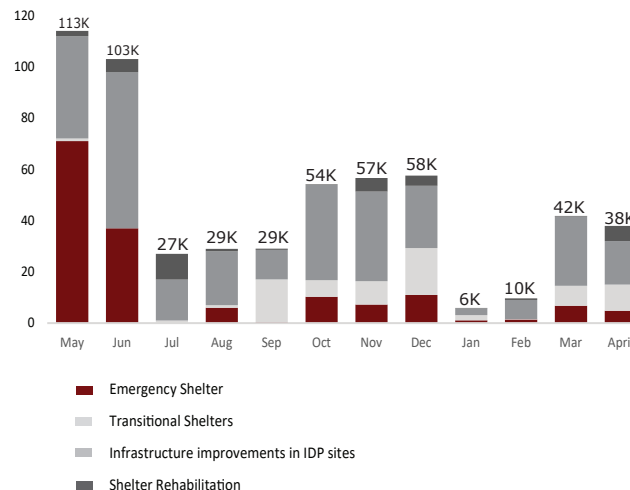
