	<p><b><u>Partner Updates</u></b></p> <p><b><u>DRC</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- shelter materials provided to 38 returnee HH in Abu Salim , considering supporting additional 10 HH</li> <li>- Planned NFI distributions for next week for migrant population in Alkrimia</li> <li>- NFI distributions planned in Souq al Juma next week for 68 individuals</li> <li>- GFFO project will start soon, the project aims to provide access to safe and adequate shelter to 285 individuals</li> </ul> <p><b><u>NRC</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Projects in Partnership with UNHCR</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Rehabilitation of 50 houses in Al Sabri Benghazi starts next week</li> <li>- Vulnerability assessments ongoing for the selection of 50 houses for rehabilitation in Tripoli</li> <li>- Technical assessments ongoing for infrastructure projects; 2 water lifting stations, 1 in Benghazi and 1 in Tripoli</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Other Projects</u></b></p>		



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Vulnerability assessments for HH level rehabilitations ongoing in Benghazi, Tawergha and Tripoli. With plans to rehabilitate 128 houses in Benghazi, 78 in Tripoli and 246 in Tawergha</li> </ul> <p><b><u>IRC</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Reached 2,450 individuals with NFI's – 11,000 items distributed</li> <li>- Distributions in urban settings in Misrata and Tripoli</li> <li>- Distribution of NFI's in DC's for 913 individuals</li> <li>- NFI's provided to 397 individuals at disembarkation points</li> <li>- 36 PSS kits provided</li> <li>- 57 individuals supported with NFI's through the CDC</li> </ul> <p><b><u>CEFA</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Distribution in Al Zawiya in response to the appeal from the municipality – supporting 81 families. provided HK, PPE and NFI's</li> <li>- Next week distribution will start in Tripoli, HK and food items will be provided.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>IOM</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- NFI's to migrants in DC's and urban settings – NFI's provided to 6,970 migrants in different locations. The items provided included summer kits , clothing and hygiene kits</li> <li>- 1,990 migrants supported in DC's and 4,980 in Urban areas</li> <li>- Activities covered urban areas and DC's in the east, west and south</li> </ul> <p><b><u>UNHCR</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Provided core relief items to families evicted from Al Fella 1 and Fella 2</li> <li>- Distributions of CRI to families evicted from Al Dawa site is planned for next week</li> <li>- NFI kits provided to 1,808 refugees and asylum seekers through Libaid and IRC</li> <li>- NFI's provided to 817 POC's in Urban areas in Tripoli</li> <li>- NFI's provided to 991 individuals at DC's (Tarki Matar, Tarik Seka, Gamfouda, Tubruq)</li> <li>- Shelter projects implemented in partnership with NRC aim at rehabilitating 100 houses (50 in Benghazi and 50 in Tripoli) and 2 infrastructure projects (1 in Benghazi and 1 in Tripoli)</li> </ul> <p><b><u>REACH</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Some delays in assessments in the west due to approval and access restrictions</li> <li>- 4 locations were covered with the reconstruction assessment (Tripoli, Tawergha, Benghazi and Derna)</li> <li>- The assessment looked at construction practices, internal and external factors affecting ability to reconstruct as well as legal aspects affecting the process</li> <li>- Analysis will be concluded in June 2022 and report presented in July</li> </ul>
