Update on issues in the North	In Al-Jauf, there are people whom may not be considered as IDPs but rather are called conflicts affected people. An assessment was conducted in 2010 and revealed the need for WASH and shelter interventions. The distributions of WASH materials, rehabilitation of infrastructure are also needed in the area. However, the distribution of shelter materials has been seen as a cause of conflict in the community.	An assessment is to be made.
