



Yemen: Camp Coordination Camp Management/Shelter/NFI Cluster CERF 2013 Project (as of May 10, 2013)

The Shelter/CCCM/NFI Cluster project aims to ensure that IDPs, returnees and conflict-affected households have equal access to safe and secure emergency shelter and basic household items (NFI) with particular emphasis being paid to female-headed households and other vulnerable individuals from the targeted groups.

27,000 individuals to be provided with Shelter Repairing Kits (Some of them will receive NFI assistance).

27,000 individuals to be provided with NFI assistance (Part of them will receive Shelter Kits).

5,400 individuals to be provided with emergency shelter assistance (who are currently occupying public buildings or still remain in Aden schools).

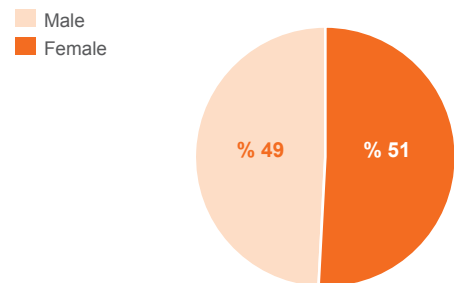
2,900 individuals to be provided with emergency shelter assistance in Hajjah and Abyan.

600 individuals to be provided with life-saving shelter

Number of districts covered by organization for each governorate

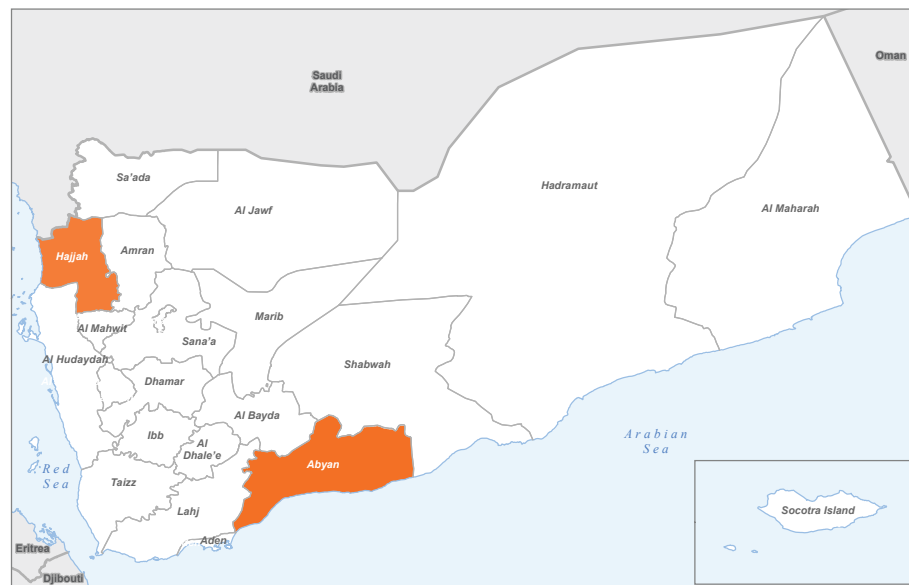

Governorates of Intervention



Project Activities:

UNHCR:

- Procure NFIs and Emergency Shelter Return Kits, and transport items to its warehouse in Aden.
- Monitor the project implementation through financial verifications and narrative reports received from its implementing partners every 2 months. Most importantly, UNHCR will conduct independent monitoring of its partners using multi-functional teams in areas of return, whenever possible.

NRC:

- Replace tents with transitional shelter in Al Mazraq Camp1.
- Conduct an assessment to identify beneficiaries in Hajjah, and build wooden emergency shelters through contractors.
- Construction of Life-Saving transitional and emergency shelter.
- Life-saving minor repairs to damaged houses.

SHS:

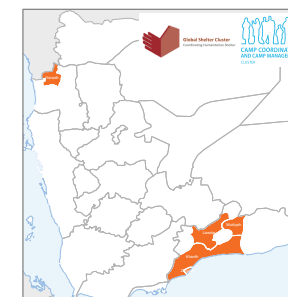
- Transport the emergency shelter and basic household items (NFI), load and off load items, and distribute NFIs, Emergency Shelter Return Kits.
- Conduct an assessment to identify beneficiaries in Abyan, and through tendering process select qualified contractors to build emergency shelter in the south.



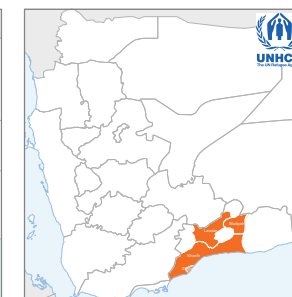

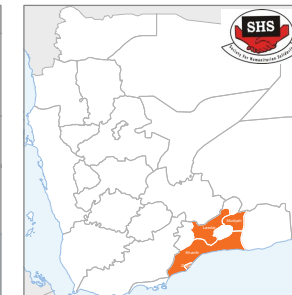

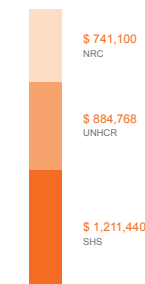
