



690,400 IDPs UNRWA designated emergency shelters (DES)

121,750 IDPs Churches, hospitals, and other public buildings

96,400 IDPs Non-UNRWA schools

550,000-600,000 IDPs Staying with host families, urban displacement

Priority needs / Urgent items required:

- 240,000 essential NFI kits (1.2M people), including bedding sets, mats, kitchen sets and washing sets to displaced populations in (1) most crowded UNRWA DES, (2) other collective centers, (3) host families/self-settled IDPs.
- 225,000 sealing-off kits (1.1M people) to (1) create additional covered space in DES yards and (2) protection and extension of host families covered living space or at self-settled IDP location, and (3) sealing off/winterization of damaged properties.
- 50,000 winterized family tents (250,000 people) for homeless families (complete with bedding sets, mats, kitchen sets, cleaning kits, dignity kits, gas cooker, repair toolkit, flashlight).

Response to date:

- Partial coverage by UNRWA of NFI needs at DES.
- Additional NFI coverage for 15,500 displaced families by PRCS/ICRC at DES.
- Distribution of 26,840 NFI kits, including bedding sets, kitchen sets, dignity sets to displaced families by ACTED, NRC, and MAAN.
- Distribution of 8,200 hygiene kits to displaced families.
