New displacements in Mansi, update/actions needed from Cluster	Cluster Lead shared the list of new IDPs in Mansi. According to Save the Children data the total is 651 HHs, 2506 across seven camps.	Action point:  Data shared with all participants.
NFIS	UNHCR have assisted NFI for 600 HHs. Each NFI kit has 8 items, including tarpaulins, blanket, mosiquoto net, plastic bucket, jalikan bucket and kitchen sets. Other agencies have distributed NFI so the total approximate coverage is 800 HHs.	
Updates from agencies	Man Waing Gyi area - KBC (North-Shan) is working in this area, currently with little/no information or data.  Momauk - About 20 HHs (100 paxs.), increased in Momauk Loi Je / Lisu Camp as of April 17.  Mansi - KBC Bhamo was informed number of IDPs increased in Mansi Baptist Camp but have not received detailed figures due tolack of phone connection.	Action point: KBC to get more precise information.
	Shalom  Bhamo - About 3 HHs (20 paxs.) increased in Bhamo Lisu Camp, coming from Loi Je.  Momauk – Need to assist with NFI kits for 4 HHs in Ni Thaw Ka Camp.	Action point: Shalom to get more precise information.

	labour/carpenters fled due to the conflict, which will delay the work. They have now found	
	another carpenter group and just started construction work. To complete 100 units of shelter	
	and 50 kitchen units in a timely manner they need second installment ASAP.

	under construction. For this site the work progress is very slow because they are encounter to
