Welcome and introductions	Welcomed all participants and a round of self-introduction, then a brief on the role of the Cluster and an overview of the agenda.	
New displacements in Mansi, update/actions needed from Cluster	Cluster Lead shared the list of new IDPs in Mansi. According to Save the Children data the total is 651 HHs, 2506 across seven camps.	<u>Action point:</u> Data shared with all participants.
NFIs	UNHCR have assisted NFI for 600 HHs. Each NFI kit has 8 items, including tarpaulins, blanket, mosquito net, plastic bucket, jalkan bucket and kitchen sets. Other agencies have distributed NFI so the total approximate coverage is 800 HHs.	
Updates from agencies	<p>KBC</p> <p><u>Man Waing Gyi area</u> - KBC (North-Shan) is working in this area, currently with little/no information or data.</p> <p><u>Momauk</u> - About 20 HHs (100 paxs.), increased in Momauk Loi Je / Lisu Camp as of April 17.</p> <p><u>Mansi</u> - KBC Bhamo was informed number of IDPs increased in Mansi Baptist Camp but have not received detailed figures due to lack of phone connection.</p>	<u>Action point:</u> KBC to get more precise information.
	<p>Shalom</p> <p><u>Bhamo</u> - About 3 HHs (20 paxs.) increased in Bhamo Lisu Camp, coming from Loi Je.</p> <p><u>Momauk</u> – Need to assist with NFI kits for 4 HHs in Ni Thaw Ka Camp.</p>	<u>Action point:</u> Shalom to get more precise information.

	<p>KMSS <u>Man Waing Gyi area</u> - KMSS is trying to get land-space to construct shelter and WASH activities. Already they have established temporary shelter in Man Waing Gyi RC Camp, for about 70 paxs. Latrines still being constructed. Distributed NFI kits for targeted group but the detail figures are not known.</p>	<p><u>Action point:</u> KMSS to get more precise information.</p>
	<p>METTA <u>Man Waing Gyi area</u> - METTA (Laisho) is working in this area. They have completed two wells and 12 latrines in Man Waing Gyi Baptist Camp and six latrines in the traditional compound. They have no other detailed information/data.</p>	<p><u>Action point:</u> METTA to get more precise information.</p>
	<p>CESVI <u>Man Waing Gyi area</u> - They have a regular plan and in May plan to distribute mosquito nets, 30 gallon water storage tanks and hygiene kits for 447 HHs and 65 HHs, the latter host families in Man Waing Gyi RC Camp. These IDPs were targeted before the April conflict.</p>	
	<p>UNHCR <u>Man Waing Gyi area</u> – As above/UNHCR provided NFI kits for 600 HHs. Other agencies distributed NFI kits as well so total coverage for about 800 HHs. Also done assessment with UNICEF, and other organizations.</p>	
How to better target NFI distributions	To be discussed in more detail with all agencies.	All Agencies
Shelter construction and update	<p>KBC 20% of materials have been collected for Momauk, Mansi, Mai Khawng and Hpan Khar Kone Camps. Thus far nothing have been done for Loi Je Li Su Camp. Stated work can finish by June-2014.</p>	
	<p>Shalom No new shelter construction apart from 28 units being renovated. They said the work can be finished in June-2014. Stated work can finish by June-2014.</p>	
	<p>KMSS <u>Man Waing Gyi area</u> - KMSS trying to get land to construct shelter/WASH. <u>Bun Tsit Pa 2</u> - Timber and other construction materials are onsite but the the skilled labour/carpenters fled due to the conflict, which will delay the work. They have now found another carpenter group and just started construction work. To complete 100 units of shelter and 50 kitchen units in a timely manner they need second installment ASAP.</p>	

	<u>Momauk RC (Man Bum)</u> - In this camp, 10 units of shelter have been finished and 10 more under construction. For this site the work progress is very slow because they are encounter to get/use hard timber for construction.	
	METTA <u>Mai Khawng RC Camp</u> - They plan to construct 50 units of shelter but the precise needs/gaps must be clarified. <u>Mansi KBC Camp</u> - They plan to construct 24 units of shelter but yet to start.	Precise needs/gaps to be clarified by METTA next week.
