<p>1: Introduction</p> <p>UN Habitat (as per early recovery aspects) and the WASH Cluster (as per water and sanitation aspects) were invited to the SAG Meeting.</p> <p>The ES/NFI Cluster Coordinator met with the MUDH to understand the development/social housing plans. Emphasis was given on DiREC and the returnee situation, with respect to the different phases of shelter programming. The MUDH requested the ES/NFI Cluster to be part of DiREC Technical Working Group to ensure consistency in programmatic standards .</p>
<p>2: TWIG ToR</p> <p>TWiG expected outputs were added to the TWiG ToR. The (preliminary) deadline set for the TWiG outputs is end of June. NRC is to co-chair the TWiG with IOM.</p> <p>Follow-up:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The ES/NFI Cluster sends out an invitation to all ES/NFI Cluster Partners to nominate Partners interested in the TWiG membership
<p>3: ES/NFI Cluster Preparedness and Response Plan</p> <p>Considerations and suggestions to be incorporated/followed-up on in the ES/NFI Cluster Preparedness and Response Plan:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In case of rapid displacement, the logistics and access becomes challenged in high-risk provinces, thus ES/NFI stocks are to be prepositioned - Possibility of sharing the ARCS warehouses - Re-confirm whether current stocks around the country are flexible for all scenarios, or if they are



restricted to a specific target population/scenario

- Lessons learned from the REACH EQ Assessments to be considered

Follow-up:

- The final ES/NFI Cluster Preparedness and Response Plan to be reviewed by the ES/NFI Cluster Partners after incorporating raised considerations/comments
