



Burkina Faso Advocacy note

SITUATION

- As of the 12th June 2020, due to insecurity, over 900K people are displaced. More than 3 times the number of people displaced when the Shelter Cluster's first strategy was approved almost one year ago.
- The funding for Shelter/NFI interventions has not increased accordingly. It has been funded up to 42% (Required 28.3M, received 11.9M)
- PIN : 1M pers ; Target: 397K pers ; 35.6% reached with shelter as of May 2020
- Partners' response capacity & geographical coverage is very limited, especially in East and Boucle de Mouhoun regions.
- 17 Shelter Cluster partners (9 active in the response at present)
- COVID-19 situation requires additional shelter support for the decongestion of host families and overcrowded sites
- The rainy season is hampering the shelter response due to the destruction linked to strong winds and heavy rains
- Access to adequate land is a strong challenge in this context

REQUEST

- Donors to increase funding and support advocacy to secure adequate land for site and integration village development
- Existing partners to scale up capacity and invitation to new national and international partners to join the response
- Non HRP partners such as ICRC to consider a specific deployment for the rainy season situation
