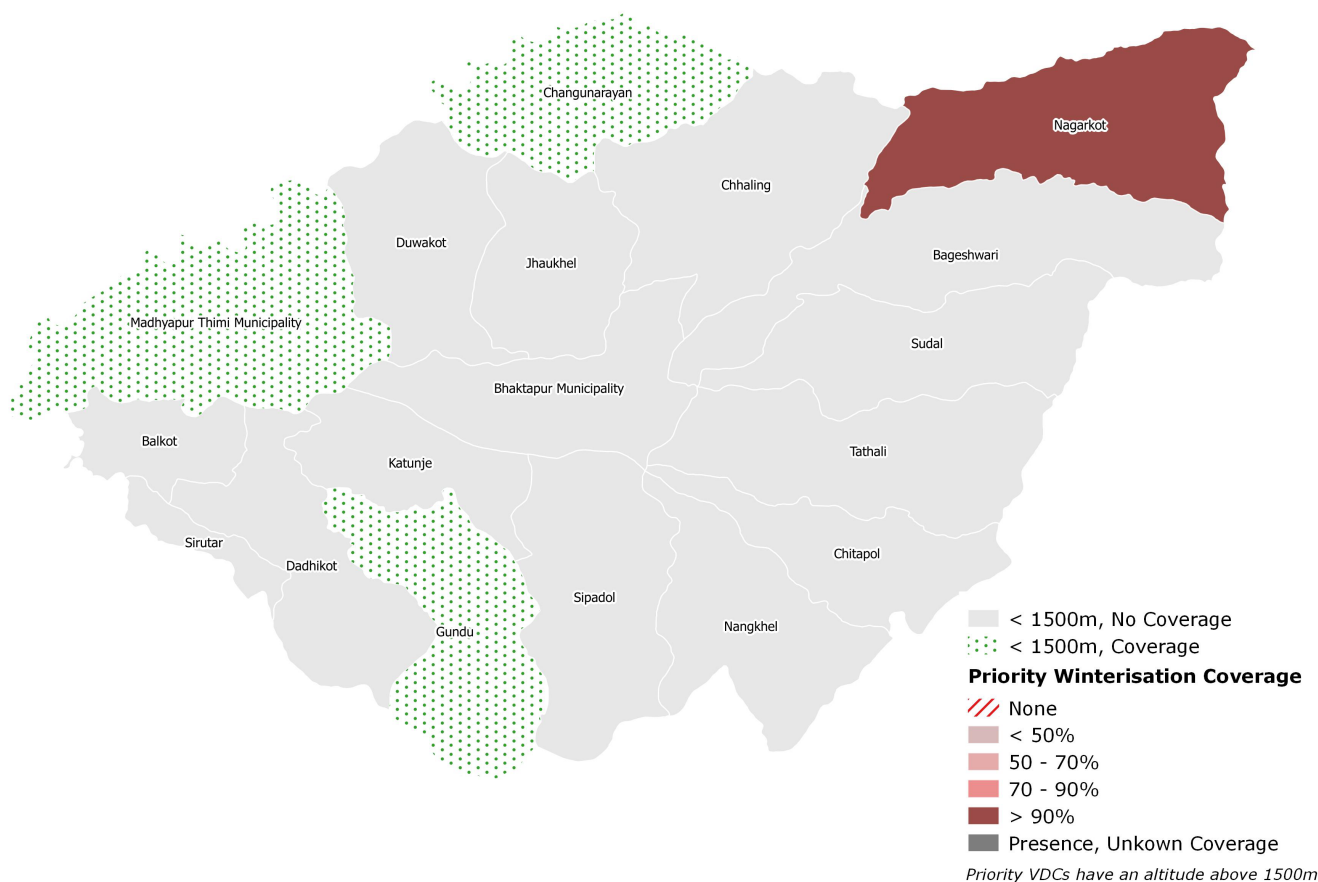

Current Situation

- DCA has completed distribution of blanket, shawl and socks to 86 HHs in Nagarkot VDC.
- Distribution of NPR 10,000 by Nepal Red Cross Society to 5,000 HHs is in plan.
- OXFAM is in the plan to distribute full package of winter kit to 130 HHs of 3 VDCs. Distribution will be started by next week.

Background

Almost 50% of total HHs were damaged. Comparatively few HHs received Cash and CGI distributions from agencies. The Nepali Government distributed NPR 15,000 to all damaged houses but this was not necessarily adequate since there are many instances of multiple families living in the same HH. A large number of people live in temporary shelter and camps, where the monsoon season caused many issues.
