CCCM JIPS

Starting in the last week of November 2016, the camp coordination and camp management agencies (DRC, LWF, NRC and UNHCR) will be conducting a humanitarian survey of people in the Sittwe Rural camps. The aim is to collect reliable information about the humanitarian situation of people in the camps. This will allow humanitarian organisations to respond more effectively to the needs of people in the future. The survey will be conducted from late November 2016 to mid-January 2017.

How will the survey be conducted?

Stage 1: Every household will be asked about the number of people in their household, their place of origin and some other basic demographic questions

Stage 2: A random selection of households will be asked a longer questionnaire about humanitarian needs and living conditions

Stage 3: Focus group discussions will be conducted in each of the camps

The survey will be conducted in all Sittwe Rural camps as well as some nearby villages. The questions should be answered by the head of the household, if they are not at home another adult household member can answer the questions.

Households that answer the questions will not receive any financial or material rewards. All information provided will be completely anonymous: no names of individuals will be noted.
