

## **Current Situation**

- Distribution of Blankets, mattress, tarpaulins and other winter items has been completed in 7,117 HHS.
- Distribution of winter kit and voucher(worth NPR 13,000) as per the SC guidance by 5 agencies to 7,771 HHs is ongoing. It is supposed to be completed by the end of December.
- Regarding the confirmed plan of various agencies, 15,542 HHs will be assisted by either in kind in coming week.

## **Background**

Dolakha is one of the most covered districts.
Distribution of temporary shelter such as tarpaulins and CGI or its equivalent in cash were widely delivered with 113,848 CGI/cash distributions being sent to more than 52,000 affected households. Although there is significant coverage in the district, there are still some VDCs which were less served due to accessibility.
