


















TO THE GLOBAL SHELTER CLUSTER 2017-2018





DG ECHO, as the main donor, together with other Cluster partners, continues supporting the Global Shelter Cluster (GSC) to implement its Strategy 2013-2017 and to operationalise the new Strategy for 2018-2022. This new contribution of 1 million Euro for a period of 24 months (1 January 2017 – 31 December 2018) will strengthen the shelter response of humanitarian actors by improving the GSC surge capacity, preparedness, and advocacy. This concerted GSC Action will be implemented by eight partners:





International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies

- Hosts a Global Focal Point (GFP) for Coordination, a GFP for Information Management (IM), a GSC Associate and a Regional Focal Point (RFP) for Asia-Pacific.
- Two preparedness workshops with a focus on localisation.



- Field deployments in support of Housing, Land and Property (HLP) issues related to shelter.
- National workshops to gather and disseminate best practices.



Development of Shelter-HLP guidelines, country profiles, and training.



- Hosts a GFP for Assessment, Monitoring and Evaluation.
- 3 country-level assessments.
- Hosts funds on behalf of the GSC for workshops, support Working Groups and Strategic Advisory Group (SAG) activities, publications and advocacy.



Cash Champions - deployment of cash/markets expertise to carry out response analysis, assessment, and technical support in-country.



Cash Champions - contribution to facilitate more predictable and formal engagement on cash matters on behalf of the GSC.



- Hosts 2 GFPs for Coordination, a GFP for IM, 2 Senior Roving Cluster Coordinators, a Roving IM, the ECHO Grant Manager.
- Two preparedness workshops with a focus on localisation.
