Lastly, following on the OCHA managed Access Survey, Charlotte Helletzgruber from the coordination section will present to the forum details on Minimum Operations Standards, in addition to Access issues and the importance of the monthly survey.
Discussion on planning capacity building sessions  A	t was noted that there is high turnover among national NGO's and partners requested from the Sector that an orientation package be created to include information products on what the sector does and where it works.  Furthermore, partners requested that capacity building needs should be identified at the field level and discussed in Khartoum. Initially, capacity building can revolve around proposal writing and reporting, in addition to further orienting partners on cross-cutting issues such as protection, gender and environment.  ****  Action points:  L. The Assistant Sector Coordinator requested that implementing partners provided an update on the Security and Population movement. Comments were as follows;

- ARC: no updates
- Assist : N/A
- Concern: NFI's were distributed to some 561 flood affected households in El Nuhood locality, West Kordofan. A post distribution is planned that will be shared with the Sector.
- NOHS: No major challenges in implementation or accessibility of activities. NOHS did conduct an assessment in October that will be shared with the Sector.
- SAG: All activities for Um Barru under the RRR Sector multi-sector response have been complete, with some 1,500 households received improve shelter and NFI items. In addition to an additional 200 improved transitional shelter to be completed planned.

# Security and population movements

- UPO: UPO conducted an assessment with HAC in Nertiti and Golo localities which covered various sectors including ES/NFI, final report will be shared once finalized. For Nertiti, the current IDP population is some 39,000 households, among them some 5,000 households are new arrivals. In the Northern camp, IDPs have received NFI items through DRC. In Golo, some 3,000 households received ES &NFI through the core pipeline and was distributed by SRCS. However, shelter conditions for both locations are dire and require replenishment.
- AORD: In Blue Nile State, it was reported that 103 households have been displaced from Bulang locality to Tadmun Locality, with an additional 40 households still displaced within the later former location. IDPs in both locations require NFI items.
- SIBRO: N/A
- TGH: In East Darfur, some 170 shelter out of 400 shelters in Garraya have been constructed. In addition to identifying some 80 shelters required in Abga Rajil in Um Dukhin locality in East Darfur.
- SORC: N/A
- NCA: NFI were distributed to some 239 households displaced from Jabal Marra, in Otash IDP Camp in South Darfur.
