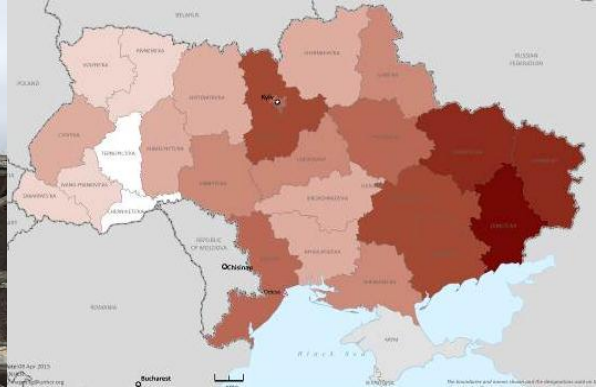

NEED ANALYSIS

On recurrent basis, needs for repairs are reported, high especially in NGCAs and along the conflict line where villages have faced heavy shelling and significant destructions.

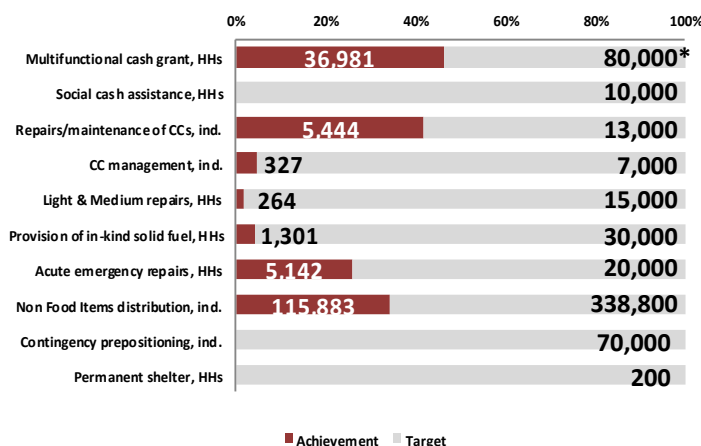
For the rest of the country, especially regions with high concentration of IDPs (Kharkiv, Dnipropetrovsk, Zaporizhzhia, Kyiv region and city, Odesa) need of support with NFIs and accommodation is constantly reported with regard to new arrivals and also previous movement.

This dual situation leads to adaptation of a strategy reflecting regional specificities. Further, remote villages in both government and non-government controlled areas require more attention as humanitarian assistance is usually not fully reaching them.

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Cluster has prepared the first release of the Summary Report on Cash Assistance post-distribution monitoring, covering first round of cash assistance provided by 5 (out of total 9) agencies in 2014-2015 ([see report](#)).
- The Government of Ukraine has pro-longed its cash assistance under Resolution # 505 and allowed IDPs to re-apply for another 6 month term.
- During the previous month a pause in rendering assistance is observed: many agencies completed 2014 projects and new are pending funding.
