1. DUDBC Update	ACTION	WHO
Shyam (DUDBC) was in Kathmandu for policy meetings:		
<ul> <li>Permanent house construction drawings and designs being finalised by DUDBC KTM.</li> <li>15 types of building options, all complying with BCN (Building Code of Nepal)</li> <li>Gorkha NRA coordination office will be set up in approx. 1 month         <ul> <li>DUDBC will work under their authority</li> <li>NRA district office will approve building and modality</li> <li>Training must also comply with NRA guidelines and BCN</li> </ul> </li> <li>Over the next month agencies should implement winterisation programmes after getting approval from DUDBC</li> </ul>		
2. Winterisation	ACTION	WHO
<ul> <li>Approval must sought from DDRC before commencing</li> <li>Government will not be implementing</li> <li>Northern and high altitude areas are a priority</li> <li>DUDBC suggests using similar modality as t-shelter implementation (cash / voucher or materials in-kind)</li> <li>Seed and food stock storage should play will need to be addressed in plans (grain and cattle) – coordinate with Food Security Cluster if agencies have stocks of tarps not allocated to winterization         <ul> <li>CGI and structure will be appropriate</li> <li>Suggested by DUDBC that "Metal Boxes" made available (traditional systems for storage of grain)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Northern very high altitude populations traditionally migrate for winter (around Nov-Dec)</li> <li>Reminder not to train for dependency</li> </ul>		
Estimates of value of packages by agencies ASAP	Survey of agencies	Shelter Cluster



3. Training	ACTION	WHO
<ul> <li>DUDBC has guidelines and manuals</li> <li>All training must be approved by DUDBC before commencing</li> <li>Training is important because agencies will not be allowed to direct implement by decree of the NRA</li> <li>Must be deemed similar enough to national curriculum by DUDBC to be approved</li> <li>Guidelines are completed and approved</li> </ul>		
4. Coordination tools	ACTION	WHO
<ul> <li>Google drive folder is set up for shelter implementers in Gorkha</li> <li>1 invite will be allowed for each organisation at any one time</li> <li>Benefits will include:         <ul> <li>Activity monitoring and mapping tailored to Gorkha agencies and DUDBC (as possible)</li> <li>Tools for programming</li> <li>Forum for surveys as required</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Agencies to select 1 person for invitation  Shelter Cluster invite people, maintain folder	All Shelter Partners Shelter Cluster
