

2015-2016 Global Shelter Cluster ECHO Grant

Implementing Partners' Selection Process

1. Process for the selection of partners to implement certain activities of the ECHO proposal

- A Global Update is sent to all Global Shelter Cluster (GSC) partners asking for expressions of interest to participate in the implementation of certain activities of the ECHO grant. The following documents are to be sent along with the Global Update:
 - The final version of the ECHO proposal.
 - A summary of the activities to be implemented by GSC partners, and the criteria for the selection of partners for each activity.
 - o A format for partners to justify how they fulfill the criteria set by the GSC.
- GSC partners interested in the implementation of these activities should inform the GSC Support Team, and justify how they fulfill the criteria set by the GSC using a short, simple format.
- The GSC Support Team will compile all expressions of interest, rate them, and then share the results with the GSC Strategic Advisory Group (SAG).
- A SAG meeting is convened to analyze the expressions of interest and the results shared by the GSC
 Support Team. The SAG makes the final decision on which GSC partner implements which activities.
