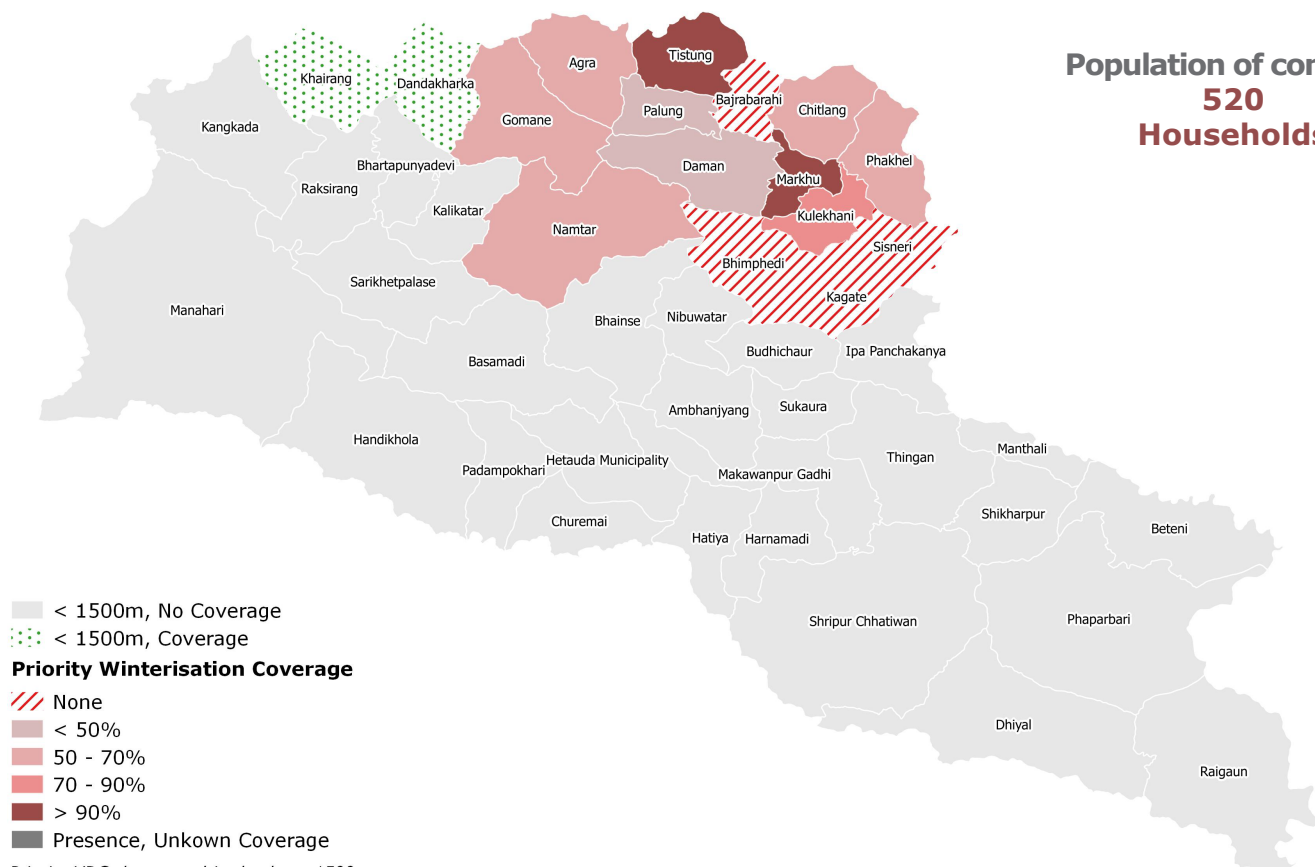

## Current Situation

- Distribution of NRP 10,000 to 2308 HHs in 5 VDCs by Nepal Red Cross Society has been completed. Similarly, ICCO with the help of CCDN has completed distribution of voucher worth NPR 12500 to 244 HHs of Chitlang VDC.
- 1303 HHs are being assisted by ICCO and Plan International by voucher and in kind in present. The distribution is supposed to be completed by the end of December.
- Tear Fund and PI have a confirmed plan to distribute cash and in kind (depending upon the need) to 5265 HHs in 6 VDCs of Makawanpur.

## Background

Makawanpur is one of the less affected districts but also one of the least served ones. Almost 40,000 households were heavily affected by the earthquake, but Makawanpur has received a little coverage; only 24% of the affected households received a tarpaulin or a tent as emergency shelter relief, but due to overlap of self-recovery item distributions (CGI or Cash), the coverage figure is nearly 100% with significant gaps in some VDCs (Hatya, Harnamadi, Padampokhari).
