Review of minutes / action points from previous meeting	 Cluster coordinator reviewed with participants the previous meeting action points as follow: MEPI-YAO was unable to assist GC in conducting an assessment in Aden. Cluster instead proposed coordination with Albasmah Foundation in Aden ,who have already conducted an assessment in Aden and shared their assessment report. SHS did not share Lahj-Tuban beneficiary list with GC. 	
Partner updates / sharing of information	 Abyan Youth Foundation AYF Conducted an assessment update for 125HH IDPs fled mainly from Taiz and Hudaidah to Dar Aldheyafah in Shoqrah, Khanfar district, Abyan. Planning to conduct an assessment update for 450HH IDPs fled from Mukeyras district in Albaydaa governorate to Lodar district in Abyan. Previously an assessment was conducted and identified 760HH IDPs from Mukeyras to Lodar the IDPs moved again after a mortar shelling started in Lodar. Reported 400HH IDPs fled from Abyan to other governorates because of security issues AQAP ruled some districts in the governorate. Reported 10HH IDPs fled from Taiz & Alhudiadah to Djibouti by sea, then to Zinjibar district Abyan by Sea. More IDPs are expected. <u>UNHCR – SHS</u>

- Paid two cash instalments out of three to beneficiaries to rehabilitate their damaged houses, project targeted 500 damaged houses in Aden. Third, final, instalment is planned to be disbursed within this month.
- Currently conducting an assessment of damaged health centers in AlDhale.
- Currently conducting an assessment of damaged houses affected by Chapala cyclone in Hadhramout.

- Reported 530 damaged houses in need of rehabilitation in AlDhale according to AlDhale authority list.
- Reported 20 recently damaged houses in Damath in AlDhale.
- Reported 250HH IDPs fled from Mawiyah district in Taiz to Alazariqah in AlDhale.
- Reported 1200HH IDPs fled from Dhamth and Al Radmah north of AlDhale to Guban,
 Qatabah and Almures ares in AlDhale.

<u>AlAmal Foundation – Lahj</u>

- Currently conducting an assessment for damaged houses in Sabir in Tuban district in Lahj.
- Reported 27HH IDPs fled from Karesh to Gol-madram area in Tuban district in Lahj.
- Reported 7HH IDPs fled from Sanaa to Alhawatah in Lahj.
- Reported 2,000 HH IDPs from Karesh to hills in Karesh due to mortar shelling which reached karesh main market. IOM conducted field visit, identified 130 HH as most vulnerable, and could not reach other areas due to mortar shelling.

Mr. Saed Alsadi Abyan coordinator reported a fake incident where he presented a fake letter stating that UNHCR will distribute 45,000+ food basket in Abyan. Another incident also reported in which a fake UNICEF project announced and conducted in Abyan.

A need was raised to establish a mechanism for coordinating between INGOs/NGOs and local authorities at governorate levels in the absence of Executive units.

To avoid such incidents NGOs/INGOs are encouraged to coordinate with local authorities during assessment and assistance distribution.
