Demolition response

| Demolished structures: | 235 | of which 82 are residential, 55 inhabited |

| Donor-funded structures: | 79 | of which 30 are residential |

64 households have received a shelter response in 2017; **7** cases are pending.

Demolition or confiscations of all structures have affected **1,510** people so far in 2017.

Gaza

IDP response

Over 6,700 families (about 35,000 individuals) remain displaced after the 2014 conflict. There is an urgent gap in assistance for approx. 6,000 IDP families requiring cash support.

There is still a funding gap for about 3,800 destroyed and over 57,000 damaged units.

GRM update

49% of the cement for the 2014 housing reconstruction caseload is still required. Estimated time for earliest reconstruction completion (if funds available): Aug 2018 86% (112,471) of the 130,693 beneficiaries in the Shelter Repair stream and 80% (5,807) of **7,172** reconstruction beneficiaries in the Residential stream have accessed full or partial amounts of their allocated materials. 598 reconstruction cases are postponed (due to lack of funds, legal issues, etc) while 77 households are yet to purchase materials.
