West Bank/East Jerusalem

Demolition response

Demolitions (Jan-Feb 2015):	322	of which 124 are residential displacing 442 individuals, including 238 children
Donor-funded structures:	108	of which 52 are residential

Monthly Average	2015	2016	% increase
All structures	46	161	250%
Residential structures	17	62	265%
Donor-funded structures	9	54	500%
Donor-funded residential	4	26	550%

During the first two months of 2016...

44 communities have been impacted by demolition, affecting **1,679** people.

In **3** incidents, most or all of the structures in the community were destroyed.

The number of residential structures demolished is equivalent to **60%** of the total number of residential structures demolished in 2015.

The **108** donor-funded structures demolished equalled the total number of donor-funded structures demolished in the whole of 2015.

50% of structures demolished in 2016 were previously affected by demolition.

It is becoming increasingly difficult to provide humanitarian aid due to **obstruction**, **confiscation or seizure** of post-demolition assistance.

Gaza

NFI Emergency response to heavy rain - Jan 2016

1,370 families received NFIs following heavy rain storms from **8** organizations.

Winterization

1,860 families received NFIs as part of winterization interventions targeting caravans and temporary displacement sites from **3** organizations.

IDP response

Over **14,800** families remain displaced as a result of the 2014 conflict.

1,047 families will receive **cash for rent** for at least 3 months in 2016 – however there is an **urgent gap in assistance** for over **10,150** families in need due to lack of funding, leaving over **6,500** families renting temporary accommodation at **risk of eviction**.

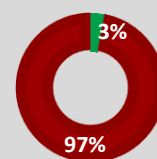

In addition, funding has been secured for **940** housing units from pre-2014, **50** of which are complete.

GRM update

Since September 2014, **1,107,519** tonnes have entered Gaza through the GRM. No additional participants were added to the Shelter or Residential Stream in February. **39%** of allocated rebar and **44%** of allocated cement in the Residential Stream has been procured. **64%** of allocated rebar and **91%** of allocated cement in the Shelter Stream has been procured. The Finishing Stream remains suspended.
