Demolition response

Demolished structures: 500 (Jan-end Oct. 2019) Of which 201 (40%) are residential, which is 60% more comparing to the same period of 2018. displaced 665 individuals, including 316 children

Donor-funded structures: 102 of which 16 are residential

108 households have received a shelter response in 2019; **12** are ongoing or pending. **8,137** demolition orders distributed between years 2010 to 2017.

Upgrading and Rehabilitation of substandard shelters (Needs):

3,350 shelters in Area C,

840 Shelters in H2 area of Hebron


350 shelters in East Jerusalem


Require rehabilitation or consolidation to ensure adequate protection and reduce risk of displacement.

> IDP response

Over **1,330** families (about **8,100** individuals) remain internally displaced (IDP) since the 2014 conflict including Nov 2018, March and May 2019 escalations. An urgent gap in assistance exists for around **1,260** IDP families requiring shelter support.


