### **Demolition response**

Demolitions (Jan 2015):	87	of which <b>44</b> are residential		
		displacing <b>116</b> individuals, including <b>64</b> children		
Donor-funded structures:	27	of which <b>24</b> are residential		

25 families have been provided with post-demolition emergency shelter assistance.

Demolitions of residential structures in January represent a 193% increase on the monthly average in 2015 and a 200% increase in donor-funded structures.

**7,000** people are at risk of **demolition or displacement** and **61** communities are at risk of **forcible transfer**.

### **Upgrading/consolidation**

In 2016, Shelter Cluster partners plan to assist 340 families at risk of displacement in East Jerusalem and Area C. **20** communities were assisted to upgrade in 2015, **87** communities remain with shelters in poor conditions that require **assistance to upgrade**.

### Gaza

### Winterization/NFIs

**275** families living in prefabricated units and **1,000** highly vulnerable families across the Gaza Strip received sealing off materials or NFIs as **winterization assistance**.

Winterization interventions for 660 households are ongoing with a further 950 planned.

### **IDP** response

**9,000** refugee families will receive TSCA to cover the previous gap for December 2015.

**700** families will receive **cash for rent** for 6 months in 2016 and **400** families for 12 months

- however there is a gap in assistance for over 11,000 families due to lack of funding.

### **Repairs and reconstruction**

In addition, **532** households that have received a third instalment for reconstruction have reportedly been completed, but are awaiting verification and final payment.

Funding has been secured for 940 housing units from pre-2014, 50 of which are complete.

### **GRM** update

As of 31 January, of **130,668** individuals participating in the Shelter Stream **97%** of those who require ABC materials for shelter repairs have been cleared to purchase materials. Of these, **76% (99,436)** have procured full or partial quantities of their allocated material. Of the **9,812** participants in the Residential Stream, **4,350** applications are for the reconstruction of a totally destroyed residential unit, while **5,462** are for construction of a new residential unit. **47%** of allocated rebar and cement in the Residential Stream has been procured.
