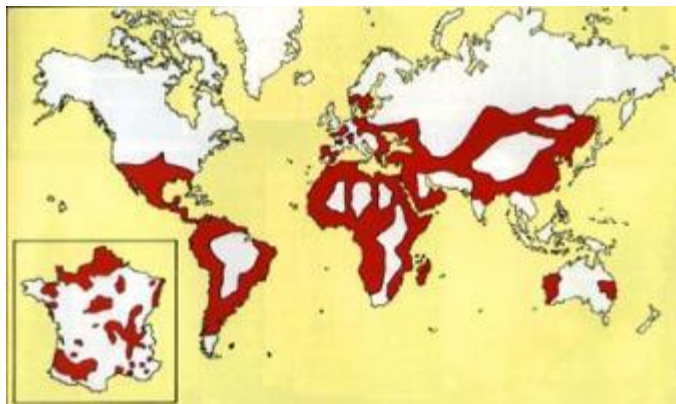

Field activities

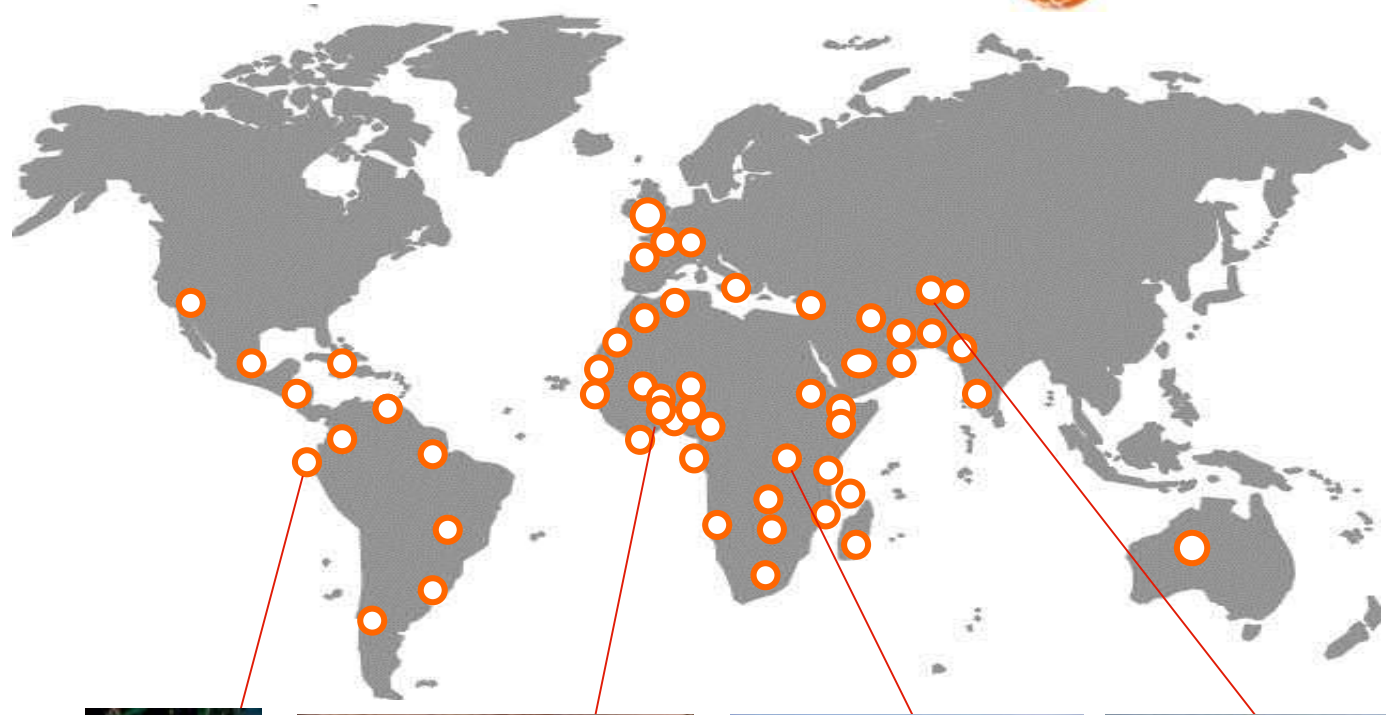


Activities implemented in more than **100** countries since 1979

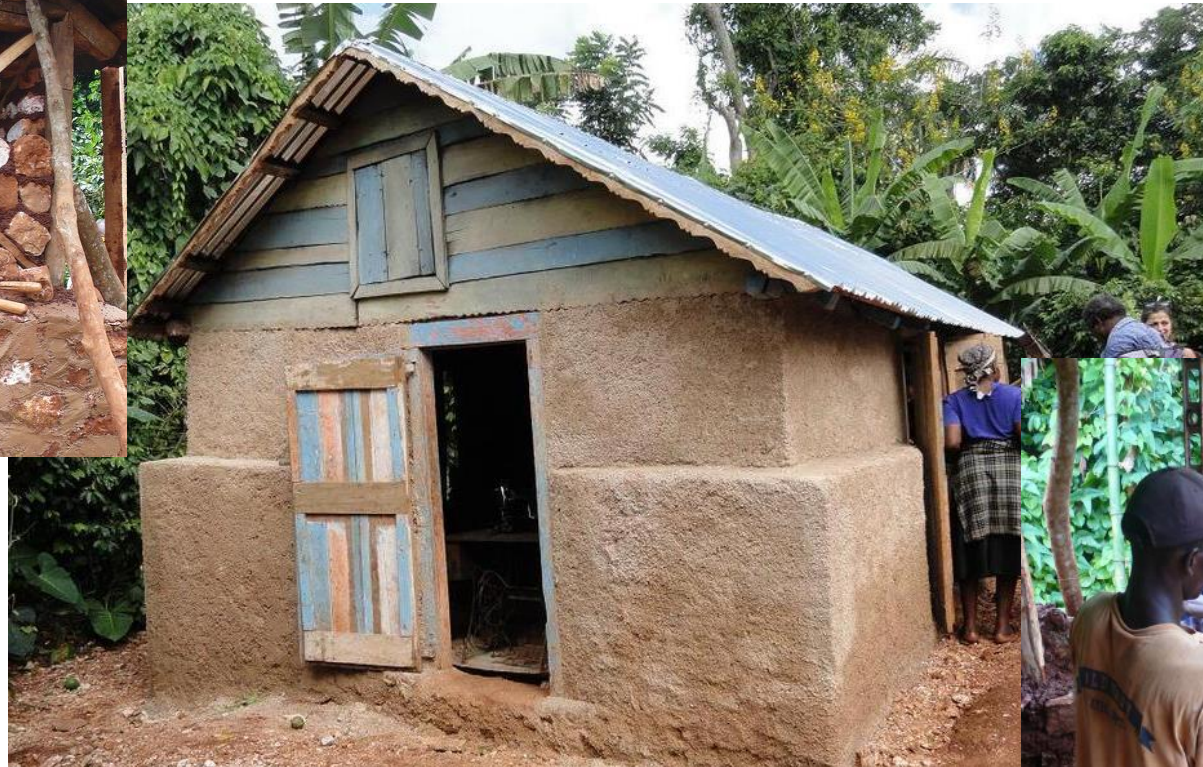
