

Joint Rasuwa Shelter Cluster and CCCM Meeting

31st August 2015

Present: Depika (Shelter Cluster), Milan (Cordaid), Radka (OM Nepal), Suraj (ADRA Nepal), Filippo (ASIA Onlus), Leelaraj (IOM), ASIA Onlus partner – Name?, and Stephen (GOAL)

As it had been a while since meeting, all present gave an account of their work to date

Asia Onlus

- Complete 4 months ago Saramtali – 1027 HHs
- Support HP and Police post – 6 and 4 bundles each
- Yarsa (wards 6 – 9) – compete beginning August
 - Distributed CGI, 1500 CFW for toilets (first of the 2,000 installment) – monitoring (hiring 3 additional staff – NAF – to monitor reconstruction of toilet. End of sept for last 500
 - LWF provide toilet materials and Asia Onlus provide training
- Langtang IDP issue – identified need, looking into provision of mules chat with 10 HHs who were already providing. Also looking into breeding of mules
 - Warehouse – one in Syafru, a 2nd warehouse needed – on langtang trail – someone needed to house – either a rub-haul tent or CGI
- CCCM
 - Provided bamboo for beds – for people of Haku
 - 525 (Haku -337 lower Rasuwa; and Dandegoan - 188) HHs bedsets, mattresses, mosquito, stoves and gas cylinders
 - Carpenters – for beds (locals already started – not great)

ADRA

- 14th Oct – aim to complete – 740 HHs in 3 VDCs – 398 t-shelters complete so far
- Using bamboo, gaben wire, cement, CGI
- Thulogoan – ward 7 and 8 – not distributed yet
- Tents - Langtang – 50 given; DDRC – 50 tents in warehouse – ADRA will request to give others to Langtang. Trying to get 16 more for Langtang (so for 116 to cover all HHs there)
- Winterisation - Not allowed to put plastic or matting on floor – so as not to destroy farming land
- DDRC asked to focus on WASH – ADRA doing assessment, complete this week. Also request for MoUs and clearer reporting -
 - Suggestion for DDRC should provide a template for all to follow. Also suggested GIZ focal point may be appropriate person

OM Nepal

- Local NGO, not INGO
- Plan – Langtang – up to 5 years – complete rehabilitation - long term plan with community
 - Working on building plans – budget and transport is very high, not eco or tourist-friendly
- Weekly meetings – Asia, Rasuwa Relief, community
- Technical working groups – communities
- Got 68 shepherds flown back – plus rice and tents

- Community starting to fix trail – 15 lakhs from tourism dept. Plan to fly people back people to work on trail - may need to recruit Haku people
- Plan to build 30 houses in Oct. – people with clear idea – which may hurt them in future
- Haku – meeting with Mylung – commitment to work with Haku people, depending on sponsors
 - CGI and food distribution done – no plan for winterization
 - Like to work in Haku also
- Trekking Experts – proposal – requesting funding for support
 - Training, raw materials, machines
 - Starting with the people from Sanu Haku living in Dunche
- Also adult literacy classes and DRR training also for adults

Cordaid

- Making baskets, carpets – camp in Daibung and they find markets
- WASH - Repaired water sources, pipelines and water tanks
- Distributed Paddy seeds
- IDP project – for one year – drinking water, toilets
 - Vocational training – centre in Naubaise ready soon
 - Agro farm also – mushroom, etc. Learn tech skills
- 2nd Phase
 - Shelter - Perm housing, toilets, etc. for 12% - 350 HHs – roughly \$2k per HH.
 - Assessment from SC criteria
 - Furniture making – CFW – in Daibung
 - Dalit's workshop – rejuvenated – in Lahrepouwa
- Office and two rooms in Kalikistan
- Mentioned 500 IDP HHs in Lahrepouwa and Daibung
 - Some still living Nuwakot – 136 HHs from Haku
 - Santi Bazar – people now willing to leave – contractor given verbal commitment to stay until after monsoon
 - 4 camps in Lahrepouwa and Daibung, - with 65, 63, 167 and 180 HHs – confirmed

IOM

IOM currently doing assessment – Rupak -1200 to 1300 people displacement

Action Points:

1. Request for DDRC to approve clear reporting template for all NGOs to follow – Partners to submit suggested formats for approval. Potentially for GIZ to coordinate, if willing.
2. Announce there will be CCCM site management training happening in two or three weeks in Rasuwa/Nuwakot
3. Resettlement Plan – biggest issue – what is government's plan? When will decision be made? Who is responsible person?
4. Land issues – who is responsible person
5. IOM doing something re training on DRR – IOM to connect relevant person to group
