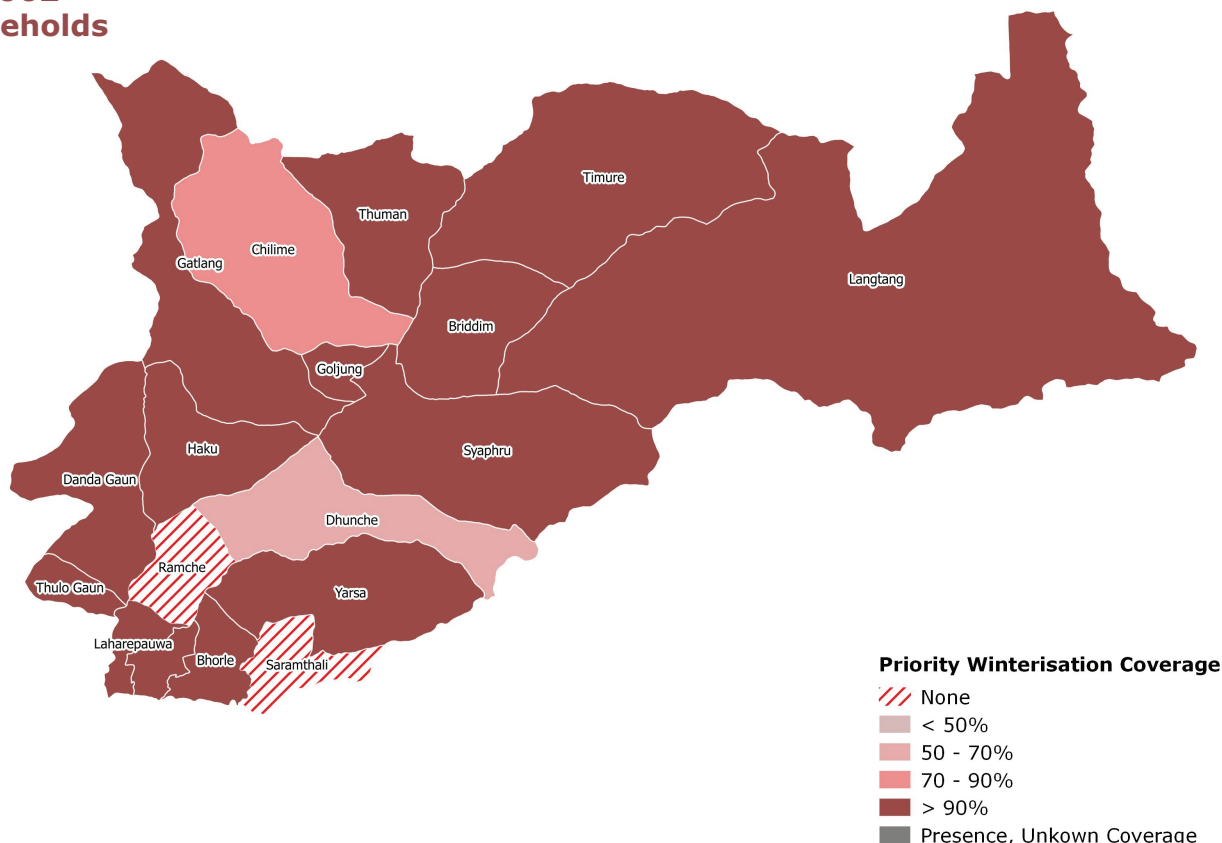

Current Situation

- Till the date, distribution of cash/in kind has been completed in 7,726 HHs of 11 VDCs which is more than 50% of the area of Rasuwa.

- CSRC, OM Nepal and LWF are in process of distribution of blanket to 5315 HHs and voucher (worth NPR 12,000) to 1266 HHs in altogether 8 VDCs.

- As a confirmed plan, 2011 HHs will be assisted by cash or in kind in coming week. Among which, NRCS has a plan to distributed NPR 10,000 to 1111 HHs.

Background

Compared to the other 13 priority districts, Rasuwa is very well served. More than 10,00 HHs have received CGI/Cash distributions. In the initial phase following the earthquakes, more than 19,000 HHs were covered by tarpaulin distributions and more than 12,000 HHs received distributions of blankets. The Nepali government has distributed NPR 15,000 to all totally damaged HHs.
