Updates from the partners			

#### Updates from the partners

- NAF Rasuwa is supporting in Dhaibung and Laharepauwa in shelter tool distribution, cash for work programs and livelihood. Similarly, NAF is building 2 Women Protection Centre in Dhaibung and Laharepauwa. NAF in coordination with Asia Onlus supported in Saramthali by providing 1,019 CGI and 572 CGI in Yarsa. Similarly, NAF is in a process to distribute gas stove sets, mosquito nets, bed sheets, plywood and bamboo in Betrawati Haku IDP camp.
- Cordaid Lumanti Parivartan, is supporting CGI distribution in Laharepauwa and Dhaibung, in which they are targeting 1,700 households, with 26 HH left to distribute. They have also organised vocational training for IDP camps.
- GOAL, has already completed CGI distribution in Syaphru, Dhunche and Gatlang. Currently, GOAL is distributing blankets from IOM. Similarly, GOAL is doing various assessments of household, market, winterisation in its 3 working VDC. GOAL is also planning for shelter construction in Dhunche, Syaphru
- Germany GIZ have completed energy and livelihood need assessment in Syaphru and Dandagau VDC and also planning to support for winterization in Dandagau and Syaphru VDC.

## Discussion on re-constructing Langtang area

- LDO invited all the interested I/NGOs to work in permanent shelter construction in Langtang VDC.
- LDO mentioned about the cultural shelter construction model in Gatlang and Langtang area and also showed interest to see the shelter construction model prepared by different I/NGOs.
- LDO also mentioned about the limitation of timber that for shelter construction program in Northern Rasuwa because of the area of National Park.
- Proposed Shelter in Langtang area are; in Goda Tabela 20 Shelter, in Rimiche 6 shelter, in Thamchet 20 shelter, in Sindup 20 shelter and in Kyanjin 20 shelter.
- LDO informed that there is committee formed in Kathmandu for Re-establishing the Langtang area.

# Reporting Template for NGOs

GIZ is providing human resource and logistic support as part of its technical assistant to DDRC to support the local administration to respond the demands resulting from the earthquake.

# CCCM site management training by IOM

It was informed in the meeting that IOM is conducting training to the interested people from different NGOs and government agencies. NGOs can contact to GOAL for registration.

### Other discussions:

- LDO and CDO updated that government has not come up with a straight planning about shelter construction. However, they are not encouraging any organisation to construct Temporary Shelter and are requesting organisations to build permanent shelter instead.
- CDO and LDO have also NGO's working in Rasuwa to organise a monitoring and evaluations trip of their activities.
- Manikor Society in support of Lutheran World Federation, distributed CGI sheet in Gatlang VDC last week, and are in the process of planning additional shelter assistance in Gatlang, meaning a duplication of CGI distribution has occurred, as GOAL are already working in Gatlang. Further discussions necessary to conclude on best course of action going forward.
