

Note* Gaps are expected to be much higher than the projected values above. Based on the limited availability of stocks shelter partners are currently distributing 1 tarpaulin per HH as part of the E-Shelter kit. In order to meet the requirements of sphere standards, 2 tarpaulins per kit are required which means projected financial requirement will be more than the worst case presented above. The following item requirements correspond to provision of minimum ES and NFI kit comprising of atleast - plastic sheet (1 per HH), bamboo (60 per HH), rubber rope bundle (3 per HH), nails 2-3" kg (2 per HH), tool kits (1 for 5 HHs), blankets (2 per HH), solar lamps (1 per HH), kitchen sets (1 per HH), sleeping mats (2 per HH) and mosquito nets (2 per HH). This does not take in to count any upgrades that are necessary for provision of improved shelter solutions for increased
