


Shelter Clsuter Assistance Frame Work for returnees:

- <u>Phase-1</u> targeted relief/stabilization assistance by ensuring returning families meet 'one dry room' principle, and includes the provision of tents as required.
- <u>Phase-2</u> would be transitional-like shelter targeted assistance through provision of shelter materials and tool kits that would kick-start the repair/reconstruction of damaged houses.
- Phase-3 would be the eventual reconstruction projects by developmental actors. Under a comprehensive response.



Assessment:

- Joint detailed assessment by cluster partners in parallel with the returns to identify the needs and the targeted beneficiaries for phase one as the most vulnerable families.
- Deliver the assistance for phase one.
- Collect data, prepare the report, analysed and aggregate data, and then design the assistance provided in the second phase of assistance.
- Delivery the assistance for phase two using the collected data.
