#### Tarps & Tents distribution:

- Fig. hasn't changed much from last update.
- There is no data for Sindhupalchowk.
- 1800 household reached in okhaldhunga and more than 50% of them have tarpaullins.

# Self-recovery shelter coverage (cash and CGI):

- Dolakha and Gorkha: full coverage (more than 100%)
- Sindhupalchowk & Okhaldhunga: No coverage

# Dhading district profile:

- 1. Update from the field
  - Temporary shelter distribution is almost complete
  - CGI distribution stopped because of UNHAS suspension but it is starting again
  - Winterization is still missing lots of funds
  - Agencies are planning to reduce the no. of items in winterization to cope up with the fund.
- Key figures
  - According to DRR 84,405 households were damaged
  - 44,455 received cash/CGI and 53,145 received tents/tarps
  - 21 agencies planning recovery & reconstruction
- Priority needs: CGI bundle (based on REACH assessment)

- Kavrepalanchowk

They have prioritized their districts on the basis of needs, data collected, political situation etc.

Solukhumbu is the area of concern.

Strategy was to have more clear communication with the locals regarding the structural damages.

In some areas,individulas have started self-recovery with structures like mud & brick; wooden house built on the original one; stone & cement etc.

They are working on the communication access in those affected areas ( Tv, Tadio, face to face communication?)
