


## Shelter Cluster Snapshot - Gaza



This Dashboard presents updated information on the shelter cluster's activates, needs and responses provided by member organizations in Gaza as a response to natural and manmade disasters (May 2021 Escalation and Winter storm Jan 2022). Remaining gaps from previous escalations are also presented.




Internal displacement from Escalations of some 1900 families (10,500

individuals) will continue due to delay in funding and reconstruction.

## Shelter Responses

TSCA for conflict affected IDPs was covered for 2021 additionally 3 months rental support (Jan-March 2022) for TD and SD homes is provided by UNDP and UNRWA



## Winter Storm 15,16 January 2022

Shelter Cluster monitored the weather extremes situation with particular focus on localities of substandard shelters with metal/asbestos roofs and vulnerable houses lacking water proofing.

The responses summarized in Table 2.


