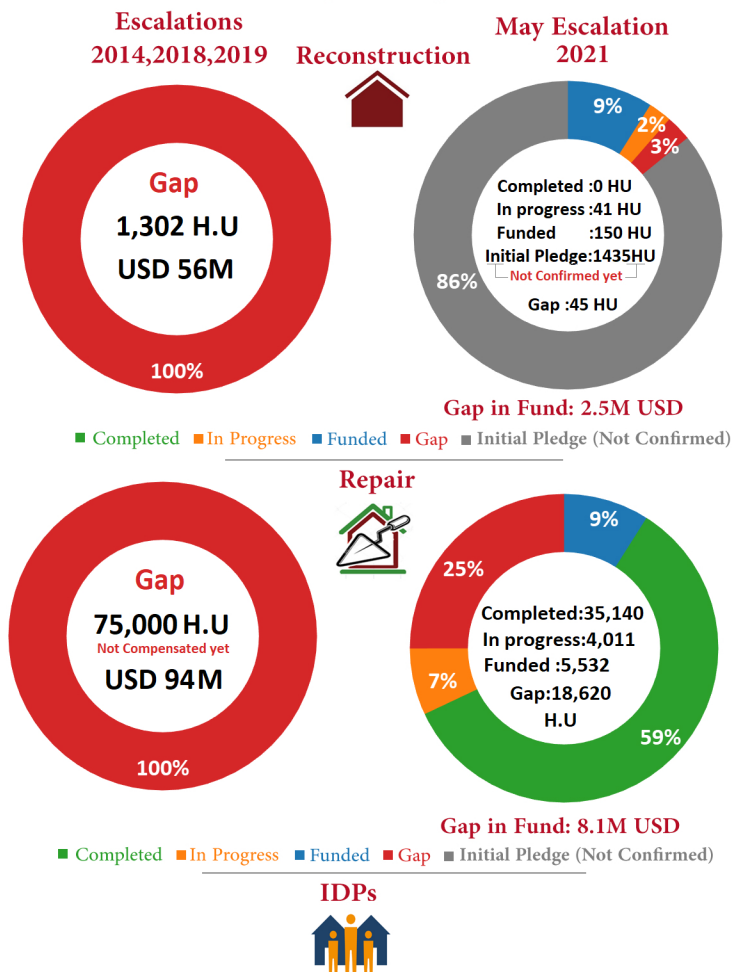

Conflict Damages Figures/Responses

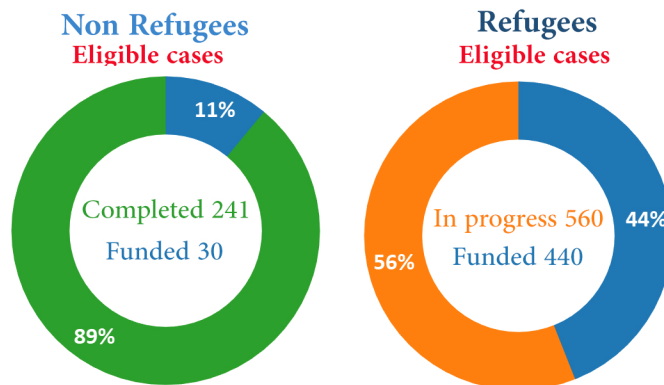


Internal displacement from Escalations of some 1900 families (10,500 individuals) will continue due to delay in funding and reconstruction.

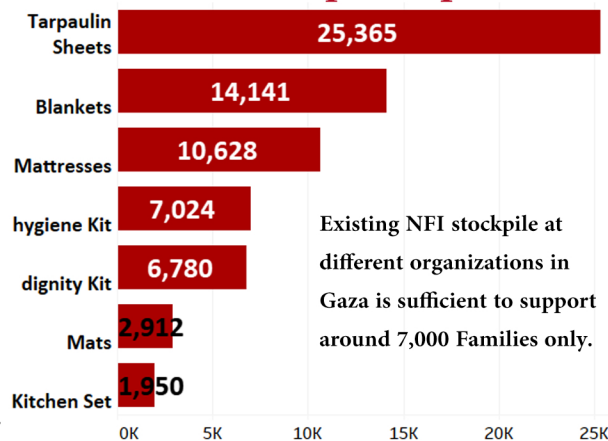
Shelter Responses

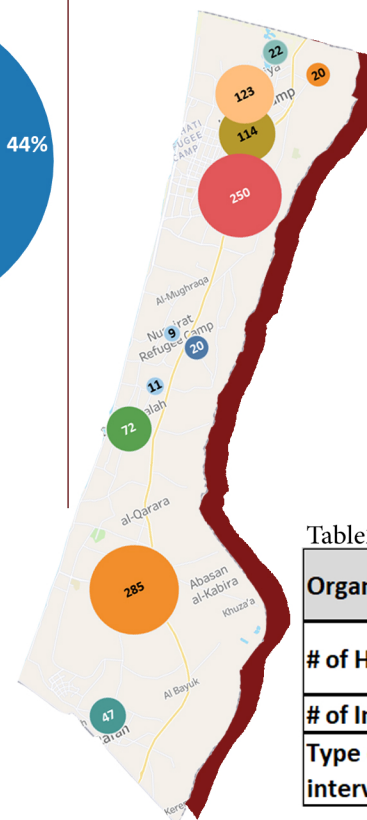
