

Overview

The conflict still ongoing in the borders of Hays district and the local authority is expecting new massive displacement. The local authority is encouraging people to move to nearby districts such as Aljarrahi and Jabal Ras as it was reported that they are intending to announce Hays district as a military zone. The ongoing fighting in Al Hudaydah governorate and other frontlines caused the displacement of 449 families in the southern region of the country during the reporting period. Generally, in the southern region, IDPs continue to be settled in Abyan and Al-Mahra governorates. The total displacement increased to some 10,342 fleeing to various locations in the north and south of Yemen.

Reponse

Al Hudaydah Hub: UNHCR through Jeel Albena has finalized the assessment for the newly displaced families in Aljarrahi district and planning to distribute 601 Non-Food Items (NFIs) and 304 Enhanced Emergency Shelter Kits (EESKs) next week. DRC has signed an agreement with IOM to distribute 500 NFIs and 500 EESKs; of which 249 IDP families assessed previously by UNHCR (Jeel Albena) will receive the assistance in Jabal Ras district and further assessment is planned for 246 IDP families in Bait ALfaqeh district. The distribution of NFIs/EESKs planned for 246 IDP families by IOM in Hajjah did not take

place yet due the the pending of signing an agreement with an implementing partner.

Aden Hub: Two assessments took place in informal settlements namely Al-Nawbah and Al-Qurno'ah which are located in Al Koud area, Khanfir district, Abyan and found that approximately 300 – 500 IDP families are residing in these two areas. Majority of the displaced families are from Taiz and have settled into these areas for over 6 – 10 months. There are no urgent needs for shelter or NFIs identified; newly displaced families are in need of NFI assistance. Post Distribution Monitoring (PDM) activity was

conducted on 14 Feb. in Fuqom area, Al-Buraiqah district, Aden to monitor effectiveness, appropriateness and overall satisfaction of 294 IDP families who have received previous assistance. IOM is planning to target 600 families and UNHCR will target over 1,600 families in Abyan governorate through the provision of NFIs. The Sub-National Cluster will ensure proper coordination to avoid any overlaps.

Ibb Hub: The Shelter/NFI/CCCM Sub-National Cluster in Ibb is currently coordinating with UNHCR, ACTED, IYCY and HFY to provide response to the newly displaced families in Ibb.
