

## Overview

Continuing conflict in Al Hudaydah governorate and other frontlines led to a slight increase of IDPs figures from last week.

In Al Hudaydah, there were 324 new families in Al Mina, Al Hawak and Al Hali districts displaced from Hays and Al Jarrahi districts.

In Abyan, increase of IDPs figures by 460 in Khanfir and Zinjibar, 229 in Aden, 41 in Tuban and 70 displaced from Al-Garrahi, Hays and Mawza to Mokha-Taiz.

## Reponse

**Al Hudaydah Hub:** DRC distributed 229 NFIs and ESK to 229 families. 21 NFIs and ESKs will be distributed this week. UNHCR through Jeel Albena will distribute NFI for 15 families in Al Mansoria.

**Aden Hub:** UNHCR plans to assist 500 families in Aden through provision of NFIs.

**Ibb Hub:** field visit was conducted to 5 families relocated to Ibb, Al Mashanah district. It was noticed that IDPs residing in schools have some worries of receiving the same services to where they will be relocated. Also, a meeting with UNHCR was held to have an update on the 300 families in Maqbanah Taizz which will be targeted by NFIs and ESKs.

## Challenges

**Ibb Hub:**

- Communication means are very poor which led to difficulties in communication with the teams on the field and some IDPs especially those resident in open areas don't have phones so that they could not be reached.

- The movement within the targeted districts in Taizz (Maqbanah, mawza'a and Jabal Habashi) are very limited by the military operations.
