- Funding for RAF database

Cluster Financing \$\$\$

- 59 % of projects funded in 2014 (USD 17,115,439)
- <u>Donors:</u> Canada, Denmark, ECHO, Japan, Norway, Sweden, USA, CHF plus UNHCR and IOM donors.
- Possible donor's fund reductions (ECHO)

- Strategy:
- Support bilateral funding/agreements
- Urgent caseload may be supported by CHF

Coordination

- SAG and TWG in place
- Participation in ICCT
- Supporting SRP and HNO development
- 7 focal points in each region
- Issues:
- Strengthening Regional coordination
- Improving Local government engagement
- Contingency planning

- Agreed and implement corrective actions

Cluster gaps

- Consolidated reporting system
- Low cluster members participation
- Considerable backlog of shelter assistance (3,931 NR)
- Need of consolidated/agreed technical standards
- Information management and websites update

Challenges

- E- Constraints on access to people in need
- E- Recurrent natural disasters, lack of DRR
- E- No parameters to analyze/predict potential displacement induced by conflict/local disputes
- E- Government involvement differs from one region to another
- Shortfall of funding
- Early Recovery interventions
- Difficulties on M&E projects
- I- Building contingency planning stocks
- Use of Cash Assistance schemes
