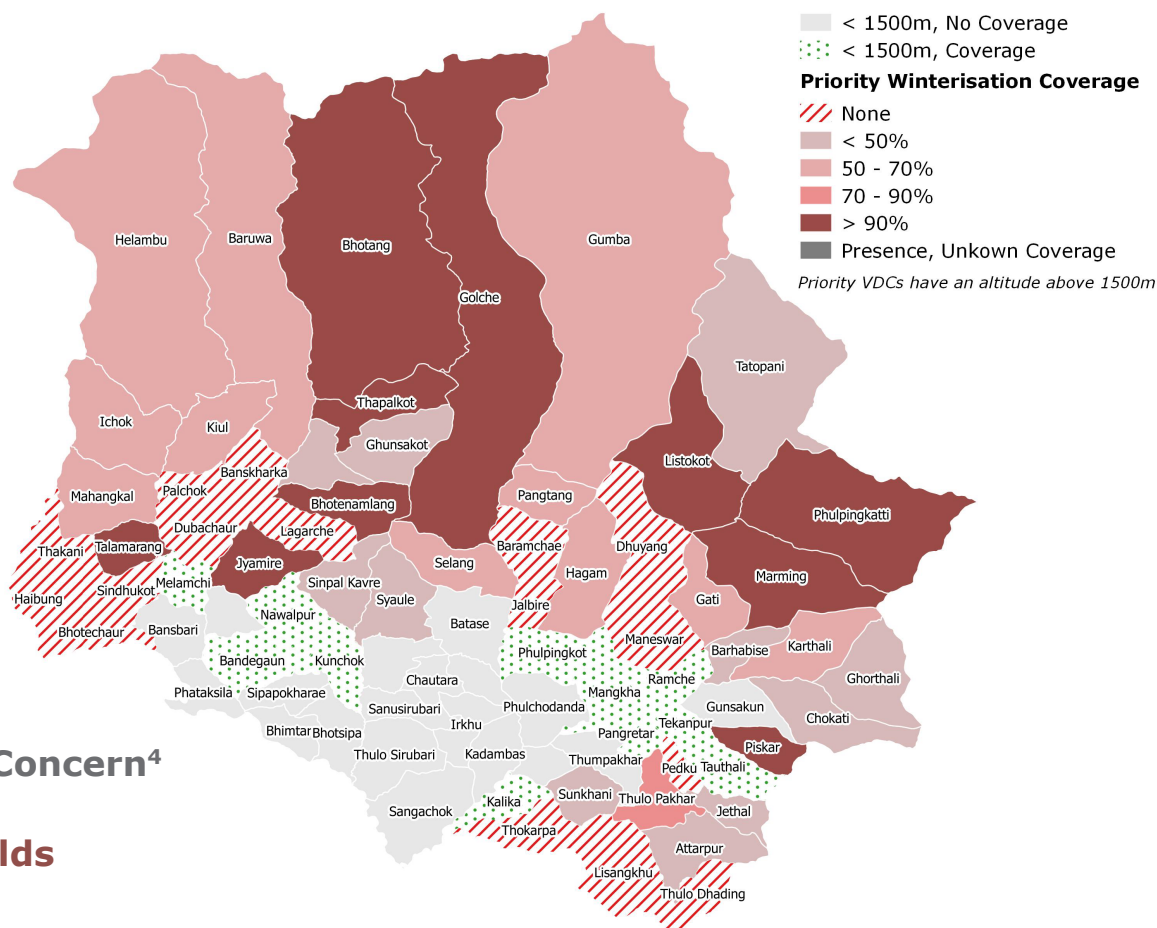

Current Situation

- Medair/Mission East has completed distribution of Cash (NPR 15,000) to 5200 HHs. In addition, ARSOW Nepal has also reported the completion of distribution of blankets in 3 VDCs to 1050 HHs.
- CARE, PI/Phase Nepal, Save the Children are in process of distribution of voucher (worth NPR 8000-13000), winter full packages and other in kind to 13,774 HHs of 19 VDCs in Sindhupalchok. Distribution will be completed by the end of December.
- As per the confirmed plan from various agencies, 15,906 HHs will be assisted by either cash (NPR 10,000), blankets or winter packages.

Background

Sindhupalchok is one of the most covered districts. Distribution of temporary shelter such as tarpaulins and CGI or its equivalent in cash were widely delivered with 133,353 CGI/- cash distributions being sent to more than 66,000 affected households. Although most of the VDCs are well covered, there are still some which are less served due to accessibility.
