

Referrals to Sub-national Shelter/NFI Cluster

Standard Operating Procedures

Objective:

Without a national standardized multi-sectorial referral system, and with shelter/NFI referrals being received by the Sub-national Shelter Cluster by various actors, a simple system to centralize referrals and track follow-up is established, adaptable to evolving needs, until such time as a national system is in place. This aims to improve follow-up of referrals, and reduce incidents of multiple agencies responding to the same referral.

Procedure:

- 1. Shelter and NFI referrals for northern Donbas (northern Donetsk and Luhansk GCA) should be sent to: coord1.ukraine@sheltercluster.org and assist.ukraine@sheltercluster.org
- Referrals received will be centralized here:

Access to the database will be granted on an individual basis to agencies who will accept referral requests.

- Based on operational presence as reported to the Shelter Cluster by implementing
 organizations, (see3W <u>here</u>), requests will be sent by email by the Sub-national Shelter Cluster
 team to agreed focal points by agency for follow-up
 - a. Referral format:
 - i. *Email title*: "Referral: Location main concern" (e.g. Referral: Pisky winterization)
 - ii. Email content:
 - 1. Copy of relevant entry in the Referral Database
 - 2. Attachment of original referral if received by email
 - 3. Contact details of original organization making the referral if relevant for more detail
 - 4. Link to database
 - 5. Reminder to update database with action taken and status of referral
- 4. Referrals received for sectors other than Shelter and NFI will be forwarded on to the relevant Cluster Coordinator / Cluster regional focal point, including in copy the original individual making the referral.
- 5. Agencies receiving referrals are requested to update the database with status of follow-up and action taken. For urgent referrals, follow-up will be made with individual agencies by the Subnational Cluster. Agencies will be invited to update on status of referrals during regular subnational meetings.
