

TEMPORARY MEASURES FOR PERMITTING POST HURRICANE DORIAN REPAIRS AND RECONSTRUCTION

A. For Minor to Moderate Repairs: permit forms should be completed for registration purposes and hurricane permit cards issued to the owner or contractor:

Minor to Moderate Repairs (non-structural and non-life safety repairs), includes but not limited to:

- Mold Removal
- Painting
- Doors and Window Repairs
- Aesthetic finishes
- Minor electrical elements plug changes
- Sheet rock installation
- Shingling and minor roof repairs (if less than 25% of the roof area).

A. For Major repairs permit forms should be completed and hurricane permit cards issued to the Contractor only:

Major Repairs includes, (Structural and life safety repairs), but not limited to:

- MEP: Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing
- Roof reconstruction
- Beam and columns
- Floors and foundations
- Framing
- Demolition/alterations to exterior or interior

PERMITTING INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR MAJOR REPAIRS:

- 1. Submit copy of Conveyance required or other acceptable legal proof of ownership of property upon which works will be done.
- 2. If applicable, submit Structural Engineer's Report on current structure.
- 3. Complete Building Permit Application with consent of owner to construct on subject property (i.e. owner must sign the reverse side of the Building Permit application).
- 4. Submit Scope of Works for the project.
- 5. If applicable, submit two (2) sets of drawings (AUTOCAD or **Manually Drawn**) of the major elements being repaired (drawings should have design professionals & stakeholder stamps & seals on plans).
- 6. Issuance of Building Permits by Building Department to a GBPA licensed Contractor of Record.
- 7. Execution of mandatory stage inspections by Building Department.
- 8. Issuance of Certificate of Occupancy to the project owner by Building Department.
