3.2 Update on Population Movements IDPs / Returnees Households (All Partners)

IOM: Reported that, during A/ISCG UNAMID reported on 57 newly displaced HH had been displaced from EJM and arrived Shadad IDPs camp between the periods 17 Jan - 08 Mar 2017 due to insecurity however, DDA already verified the information and identified the reported HHs were registered since Jan 17, whom seasonally returned to their villages of origins and came back to the camp again. IOM will verify the information once again and will share the result.

3.3. Update on Disaster Affected IDPs households (All)

VRNHD: Reported that, 25 HH affected by fire in their geographical areas between the periods of 13-20 Mar 17. The below table shows the breakdown:-

Zam Zam IDPs camp:

IOM: Provided full baskets of NFIs for 1,760 PWSNs in Zam IDPs camp, distribution conducted by Plan International between the periods of 12-22 March 2017.

Tawilla IDPs camp

El Ruhama: Managed to distribute Age friendly baskets kits included (mosquito nets, Jerry cans 20 ltr, Buckets, washing soaps, and Pitchers) for 65 vulnerable disabled persons also they conducted training sessions for 37 community members on transitional shelters construction, environmental conservation and environmentally friendly disposal of NFIs.

Karnoi locality: SSB Project

UPO: Reported that, they completed construction of 36 permanent shelters (34 in Karnoi town, 01 in Gatat and 01 in Garsilba) expected to complete the remaining of 64 shelter over the mid of April 17.

4.1 Update on Planned humanitarian assessment mission undertaken (OCHA/All Partners)

Kuara

RRR-Sector managed to complete registration & verification exercise for returnees in 20 villages within Kaura areas between the periods of 15-21 March 17 and will share the result shortly.

Al Lait locality:

OCHA: Reported on Al Lait Inter-agency mission to assess the humanitarian needs for newly displaced in 04 villages within Al lait locality (Fataha, Dalil Babiker and Fajakh), the team managed to visit the areas between the periods of 19-23 Mar 17.

ES/NFI: Reported, that, UNHCR and COR will lead a mission to Al lait between the periods of 26 March to 14 April 2017, the main objective of the mission is to conduct registration for the reported figure of 19,531 individual for South Sudanese Refugees scattered in 10 locations within Al lait locality however; WFP, IOM and HAC will be participated on the planned mission.

AOB:

ES/NFI: informed the meeting that, the sector partners applied for SHF 2017 were not eligible to receive funding due to the short of fund, however; they reminded on extension of OPS submission until 06 April 2017.
