▶ Background

Military operations between SAF and SLA in EJM continued to result in the displacement of people to various locations in North Darfur. ES/NFI assistance was provided to 3940 households in Tawilla IDP camp and Shangil Tobiya, following verification by partners DDA and SAG during the reporting period.
