Background

Verification of households displaced as a result of the conflict between the government and SLA armed forces in East Jebel Marra during the period January – June 2016 continued during the reporting period. Some 1800 HHs in Sortony in Kabkabiya Locality, North Darfur was assessed and ES/NFI assistance was provided to 1,720 households after verification by partner KSCS.
