Displacement due to Disaster: Fire

► Background

Some 154 households in Millet, El Fashir, Kabkabia, Darelslam ,Kalemando, localities were reported to have been displaced due to the destruction of their shelters by fire. ES/NFI assistance was provided to 121 households following verification by partners Oxfam America, SAG, KCSC, DDA and Plan Sudan.

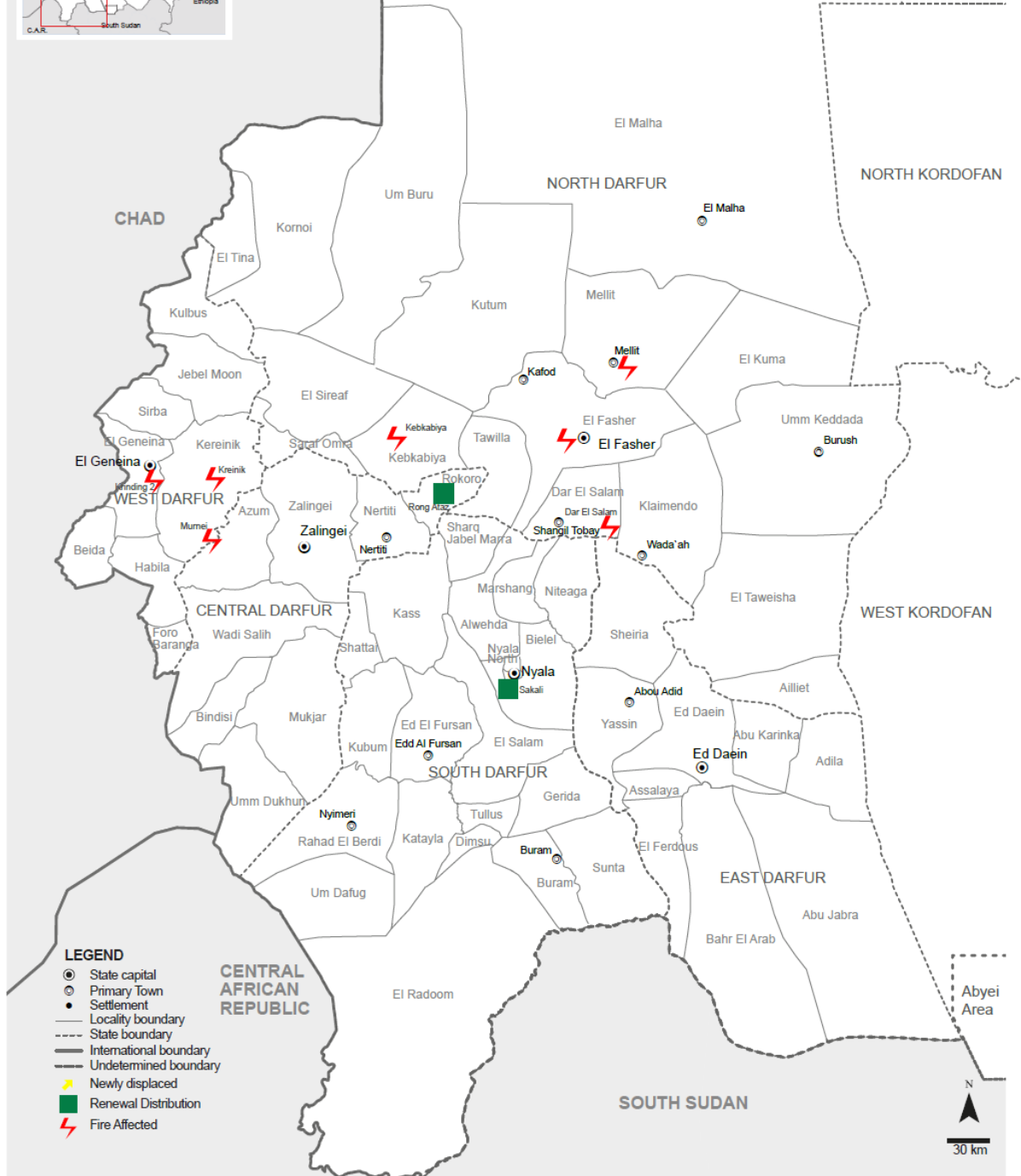
